ORDER:

In the Government Order 1st read above, orders have been issued for starting of 8 DNB Courses with 36 seats in the 14 District Hospitals with the financial sanction of Rs.8.15 crore as approved in PIP during the year 2016-2017.

2. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services in the letter second read above has stated that the following additional work have to be done for the commencement of DNB Courses;

- i) Preparation of the Hospitals for Inspection for accreditation by the National Board of Examination for conducting the DNB Courses;
- ii) Obtaining accreditation of National Board of Examination for the DNB Courses;
- iii) Ensuring the availability of faculties for conducting the DNB Courses in the selected hospitals;
- iv) Arrangement of class rooms, demo rooms and library rooms for the DNB candidates;

- v) Arrangement for library books and e-journals;
- vi) Provision of stipend to the DNB candidates;
- vii) Separate allocation of funds for conducting DNB Courses and maintenance of the same;
- viii) Periodical faculty development workshop and training to the faculties in recent development in medical field;
- ix) Arrangements for the trainees to visit Medical College Hospitals during their course period; and
- x) Preparation of other District Head Quarters Hospitals for the accreditation of more number of courses.

3. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services has, further, stated that as per the norms of DNB, provision of a library for easy reference, with a qualified librarian is necessary in all Government Hospitals where the course is being conducted and the Government of India has sanctioned a sum of Rs.8.15 crore towards the conduct of DNB Courses in the Programme Implementation Plan 2016-2017 of the State Health Society. In the 32nd Executive Meeting of the State Health Society held on 10.03.2017 under agenda 9/2017 among others, it has been resolved as follows:-

- i. The Mission Director is permitted to release the fund from the National Health Mission – Reproductive and Child Health (A.9.8.4.5.- commencement of DNB Courses in District Head Quarters Hospitals) approved amount to the Director of Medical and Rural Health Services for the commencement of the DNB Programme;
- ii. The purchase of recommended library books and online e-journal subscriptions to be made in the name of the respective hospitals only; and
- iii. The Mission Director if permitted for appointment of following posts will be through outsourcing made as per NHM norms and as per the qualification mentioned below:-
 - a) Librarian cum Statistician : Bachelor's degree in B.Sc/ B.Com/B.Sc with Degree in Library and Information Science with computer knowledge with a salary of Rs.22,000/- per month;
No. of Librarians: 11 by respective Joint Director of Health Services through District Health Society;
 - b) Statistical Assistant :
B.Sc. Degree or B.Com. degree of any university with statistics as an ancillary subject with computer knowledge with a salary of Rs.22,000/- per month ;
No. of Statistical Assistant : 1 through Director of Medical and Rural Health Services; and

c) Office Assistant : Rs.9,000/- per month

No. of Office Assistant: 1 through Director of Medical and Rural Health Services

4. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services has, therefore, requested the Government to issue necessary orders on the following:-

- i) The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services may be permitted to fill the contractual staff through outsourcing;
- ii) The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services may be permitted to appoint a Nodal Officer, Superintendent and 3 Assistants on diversion from any office under their control; and
- iii) The respective Joint Director of Health Services may be permitted to purchase the required library books and online e-journals subscriptions in the name of respective hospitals as per DNB norms.

5. The Government after detailed examination and have decided to accept the request of the Director of Medical and Rural Health Services and orders as follows:

- i) The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is directed to assign any Medical Officer in the cadre of Deputy Director / Joint Director in the Directorate of Medical and Rural Health Services for the works relating to the commencement of the DNB Courses at Government Hospitals;
- ii) The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is permitted to fill up the following posts on contract basis through outsourcing with the educational qualification prescribed for the post and the pay for the post mentioned therein:

a. Statistical Assistant : – 1 post

B.Sc. Degree or B.Com degree of any university with statistics as an ancillary subject with computer knowledge with a salary of Rs.22,000/- per month ;

b. Office Assistant: -1 post

with a salary of Rs.9,000/- per month

- iii) The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is permitted to appoint a Superintendent and 3 Assistants on diversion from any office under their control; and
- iv) The concerned Joint Director of Health Services are permitted to fill up the post of Library cum Statistician through outsourcing with the qualification and pay for the post as follows:-

Librarian cum Statistician: Bachelor's degree in B.Sc/ B.Com/B.Sc with Degree in Library and Information Science with computer knowledge with a salary of Rs.22,000/- per month;

- v) The concerned Joint Director of Health Services are permitted to purchase the required library books and online e-journals subscriptions in the name of respective hospitals as per DNB norms.

6. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is directed to take action accordingly .


