



ABSTRACT

National Health Mission – Tamil Nadu – Civil Works – Construction of New Buildings in 16 Primary Health Centres / Upgraded Primary Health Centres – Revised Administrative sanction - Additional funds for a sum of Rs.281.72 lakhs - Sanctioned - Orders - Issued.

ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the Government have permitted the Mission Director, National Health Mission to utilize the State share of liquidation of arrears for infrastructure maintenance to the tune of Rs.4,65,25,000/- (Rupees Four crore sixty five lakh twenty five thousand only) to complete the civil works in 23 Primary Health Centres / Upgraded Primary Health Centres under National Health Mission and issued necessary revised administrative sanction orders.

2. In the letter second read above, the Mission Director, National Health Mission has stated that, the National Rural Health Mission has been funding for civil works for constructing new buildings to New Primary Health Centres and Upgraded Primary Health Centres and for providing additional facilities to Primary Health Centres and Government Hospitals in the State. Due to delay in finalization of site, new constructions could not be commenced promptly. Moreover for certain works, due to soil conditions of the identified site, additional works such as filling the low lying area has to be carried out in additional basement structures and the construction of structures in hilly areas. Hence, additional funds are required in excess of the approved amount for the civil works. Further, the revision of schedule of rates every year, the cost of works, which have not been started, goes on increasing and hence, the additional funds are required. However, the Government of India hasn't approved the proposals included in PIPs for additional funds. Necessary additional fund is required to complete the various works. Further, the Primary Health Centres which are functioning in temporary buildings with constraint space finds difficulty to deliver health care services effectively to Rural Population. In this regard, a detailed agenda vide No.12 had been placed in 31st Executive Committee meeting held on 07.11.2016 and the same has been approved. Hence, the Mission Director, National Health Mission has requested to permit him to utilize funds of Rs.1373.93 lakh from the available funds, towards the provisions of additional funds to 62 civil works under National Health Mission. Out of 62 civil works, orders have been issued to utilize the fund of Rs.465.25 lakhs from the available funds, for providing additional funds

to 23 works in G.O. first read above. In respect of other 39 works, Public Works Department was referred for the approval of Tender Awarding Committee (TAC) and 13 works were approved. Besides, the Tender Awarding Committee approvals were also issued newly for 9 works, which are other than 62 works previously proposed by National Health Mission. Further, the Mission Director, National Health Mission has stated that, a detailed circulation note vide No.13 had been submitted to Executive Sub Committee, State Health Society – Tamil Nadu seeking permission to permit him to remit / release the additional funds required for 5 civil works as detailed below:-

Finally, the Mission Director has requested to provide the additional funds aggregating to Rs.281.72 lakh for the 16 civil works and requested necessary orders in this regard.

3. The Government after careful consideration have decided to accept the proposal of the Mission Director, National Health Mission and accordingly issue the following orders:-

- (i) Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.281.72 lakh for execution of Civil Works in 16 Primary Health Centres / Upgraded Primary Health Centres as detailed in the annexure to this Government Order, through the Public Works Department.
- (ii) The Mission Director, National Health Mission is instructed to remit the amount of additional fund towards the 16 civil works to the tune of Rs.281.72 lakhs into State Government account as per the existing procedure and to obtain necessary approval for such activity from National Programme Co-ordination Committee (NPCC) in the subsequent PIP.
