Health and Family Welfare Department – Setting up State Cancer Institute (SCI) at Cancer Institute, Adyar, Chennai under Tertiary Cancer Centre Scheme of National Programme for Prevention and Control of Cancer, Diabetes, Cardio Vascular Disease and Stroke Program in 12th Five Year Plan (2012-17) – Sanction of balance State share of Rs.3.08 Crore –Accorded - Orders- Issued.

ORDER:

The Government of India have approved the scheme to enhance the Tertiary Care Cancer facilities by setting up of State Cancer Institute in Cancer Institute (WIA) Adyar, Chennai and one time financial assistance upto Rs.120 crore was envisaged for the above said State Cancer Institute inclusive of Government of India share of 75% and State share of 25%. Further, the Government of India had released Rs.67.38 crore to State Government account as first installment in 2014-15 to upgrade the Adyar Cancer Institute as State Cancer Institute under National Programme for Prevention and Control of Cancer, Diabetes, Cardiovascular Disease and Stroke Program.

2. In the Government Order first read above, among others, the Government have sanctioned a sum of Rs.89,84,00,000/- i.e., Rs.67,38,00,000/- being 75% of the Government of India grants-in-aid and Rs. 22,46,00,000/- being 25% of State Share to upgrade the Adyar Cancer Institute, as State Cancer Institute under the National Programme for Prevention and Control of Cancer, Diabetes, Cardiovascular Disease and Stroke program for the year 2014-15 subject to the terms and conditions prescribed in Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) and also subject to the following terms:

- i. The recurring cost to be met by the Adyar Cancer Institute itself (If any from new project)
- ii. The extent of free treatment being given a relook, considering the huge investment afresh by Government of India / Government of Tamil Nadu.

3. In the Government Order Second read above, among others, the Government have sanctioned sum of Rs.22,46,00,000/- of State share as second installment for setting up State Cancer Institute at Cancer Institute, Adyar under Tertiary Cancer Centre Scheme of National Programme for Prevention and Control of Cancer, Diabetes, Cardiovascular Disease and Stroke program in 12th Five Year Plan (2012-17), Subject to the terms and conditions prescribed in Memorandum of Understanding and in the Government order first read above.

4. The Chairman, Adyar Cancer Institute in her letter 3rd read above, has stated that, they have reached the end of the State Cancer Institute Project both in terms of the building and equipments. Out of Tamil Nadu State Government share of Rs.48 crore, the Institute had received Rs.44.92 crore leaving a balance of Rs.3.08 crore. In the context of the financial crunch due to the pandemic, she has again appealed the Government of Tamil Nadu for the release of the balancing grant of Rs.3.08 crores pending with the Government of Tamil Nadu.

5. The Government have examined the request of the Chairman, Cancer Institute, Adyar in detail and decided to accept the same. An amount of Rs.67.38 crore (60%) has been released by Government of India to Cancer Institute, Adyar in 2014-15. Further, based on the above release of the Government of India, the Government of Tamil Nadu has released a corresponding State share of Rs.44.92 crore, for setting up State Cancer Institute at Cancer Institute, Adyar, Chennai under Tertiary Cancer Centre Scheme of National Programme for Prevention and Control of Cancer, Diabetes, Cardiovascular Disease and Stroke (NPCDCS) in 12th Five Year Plan (2012-17). The remaining Government of India share of Rs.4,62,00,000/- is not released yet. Pending release from the Government of India, the Government hereby accord sanction for remaining State share of Rs.3.08 crore (Rupees Three crore and Eight lakh only) for setting up State Cancer Institute at Cancer Institute, Adyar, Chennai under Tertiary Cancer Centre Scheme of National Programme for Prevention and Control of Cancer, Diabetes, Cardiovascular Disease and Stroke (NPCDCS) in 12th Five Year Plan (2012-17), subject to the terms and conditions prescribed in Memorandum of Understanding and in G.O(Ms).No.269, Health and Family Welfare (EAP-II) Department, dated:03.09.2015.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following Head of account:-

" 2210 Medical and Public Health – 80 General 800 Other Expenditure – State's Expenditure – AD Grants to Private Medical Institution under the Control of Director of Medical Education – 309 Grants-in-Aid-01 Grants for current Expenditure"

Old (DPC 2210-80-800-AD 0915)

7. Necessary additional funds of Rs.3.08 crores will be provided in the RE / FMA 2020 – 21. Pending provision of such funds, the Director of Medical Education is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 5 above. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by Specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates 2020-21. The Director of Medical

Education is also requested to include this expenditure while sending the budget proposals for RE / FMA 2020 – 21 and draft explanatory notes for Supplementary Estimates 2020 – 21 to Government in Finance (Health-II/BG-I) Department without fail.

8. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.33950/Health-II/2020, dated: 17.10.2020 and ASL No.717 (Seven hundred and seventeen).
