Dearth of qualified Post Graduate teachers in the Speciality in Tamil Nadu State.



On careful consideration of the proposal, the Government of Tamil Nadu have decided to issue "Essentiality Certificate" to the applicant for starting of **MD (Community Medicine) with an annual intake of 5 seats per year at Stanley Medical College, Chennai** from the academic year 2016-2017, subject to the condition that the approval of Medical Council of India / Government of India should be obtained before the students are admitted.

It is certified that:-

- (a) It is desirable to start **MD (Community Medicine) with an annual intake of 5 seats per year** in the public interest.
- (b) Starting of **MD (Community Medicine) with an annual intake of 5 seats per year at Stanley Medical College, Chennai** is feasible.
- (c) The institution in the said department is having adequate clinical material as per the Medical Council of India norms.

It is further certified that in case the applicant fails to create infrastructure for the course as per Medical Council of India norms and fresh admissions are stopped by the Central Government, the State Government shall take over the responsibility of the students already admitted in the above said course at this College with the permission of the Central Government.
