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ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the orders were issued for granting permission to start Multipurpose Health Worker (Female) / Auxiliary Nurse Midwife Training course by Private Institutions with prescribed fees.

2. In the Government Order 2<sup>nd</sup> read above, the Government have amended the norms and guidelines to grant permission to start Auxiliary Nurse Midwife course by Private Institute issued in the Government Order first read above, whereby the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine shall be the Board of Examination for the Auxiliary Nurse Midwife courses conducted by the institution henceforth.

3. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine has stated that as the Government have permitted the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine as Board of examinations for Private Auxiliary Nurse Midwife Training Schools, it is necessary to fix the fee structure for collection of various fees from the Auxiliary Nurse Midwife Course students as well as from the Private Auxiliary Nurse Midwife Training Schools. As such, he has proposed to fix fee structure for 2 years Auxiliary Nurse Midwife Training course as noted below:-

- I. Fee to be paid by each Private Auxiliary Nurse Midwife Training School to Board of Examination Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine(Auxiliary Nurse Midwife Course)/Government Account:-

1. Auxiliary Nurse Midwife School  
Registration Fee (per annum) : Rs. 500/- #

2. Provisional Affiliation & Consent Fee : Rs. 10,000/-<sup>#</sup>  
(per annum)
3. Board Administrative Expenses fee : Rs. 500/-<sup>#</sup>  
(Per student)
4. Sanitation Certificate Fee (per : Rs. 1,000/-\*  
annum)
5. Occupation Certificate Fee (for each : Rs. 1,000/-\*  
new building)

\*As per Section 26 & 33 of Public Health Act it is mandatory to have these certificates by all Schools and new buildings.

**#For items 1, 2 & 3 – Mode of Payment:**

By means of Demand Draft in favour of Board of Examination, Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine, Chennai.

**\*For items 4 & 5 – Mode of payment:**

By means of Challan in the following Head of Account:-

“0210 Medical and Public Health – 04 – Public Health – 800  
Other Receipts – AD – Other Public Health Receipts”

II. Fee to be paid by each students through the Private Auxiliary Nurse Midwife Training School to the Board of Examination / Government Account

1. Board Registration Fee (one time) : Rs. 500#
2. Examination Fee : Rs.10,000#
3. Issue of Duplicate Certificate : Rs. 100#
4. Fee for Internship period per student : Rs. 1,000\*

**#For items 1, 2 & 3 – Mode of Payment:**

By means of Demand Draft in favour of Board of Examination, Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine, Chennai.

**\*For items 4 – Mode of payment:**

By means of Challan in the following Head of Account:-

“0210 Medical and Public Health – 04 – Public Health – 800  
Other Receipts – AD – Other Public Health Receipts”  
(D.P. Code 0210-04-300-AD 0000)

4. The Government, after careful examination, have decided to accept the request of the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine and orders to fix the fee structure for collection of various fees from the Auxiliary Nurse Midwife Course students as well as from the Private Auxiliary Nurse Midwife Training Schools as mentioned at para 3 above.

5. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine is requested to take necessary action to amend the relevant clauses of Tamil Nadu Public Health Establishment Act 1939, Rules and Regulations 1940 wherever it is required as per rules in force.
