ORDER:-

The Director (i/c) Tamil Nadu State Health Transport Department has stated that he has not disposed any of the Tyres and Tubes from 2012 since the period of validity for all the approved co-operative societies got expired during different months during the year 2012. Now, 1614 (approx.) sets of Tyres and Tubes have been accumulated in the different units of Tamil Nadu State Health Transport Department and the quantity keeps on increasing day by day since old tyres are replaced by new tyres. They are regularly received and taken into stock by Tamil Nadu State Health Transport Department. Further Tamil Nadu State Health Transport Department has been requested to make arrangements to keep in safe custody the old tyres from 108 Ambulances and Free Hearse Service vehicles and about 1000 tyres with tubes will be received, very shortly by the Tamil Nadu State Health Transport Department.

2. The Director (i/c) Tamil Nadu State Health Transport Department has also stated that the Tamil Nadu State Health Transport Department has now, faces great hardships in storing the above said huge quantity of old tyres. Moreover, it is a known fact that improper storage of old tyres will lead to breeding of mosquitoes and thereby causing the outbreak of vector borne diseases. Hence drastic steps have to be immediately taken to dispose off the accumulated old tyres. Further, the Accountant General (Civil audit) during the Audit conducted in this Department for the year 2012-13 has also pointed out and directed the Tamil Nadu State Health Transport Department, in one of the objections raised, to dispose them early to the best advantage and the sale proceeds shall be credited into the Government Account.

3. The Director (i/c) Tamil Nadu State Health Transport Department has requested the Government to permit him to take action to dispose of the

accumulated old tyres to the approved Co-operative Societies through limited tender basis in the rates not below the rates mentioned below:

- i) Heavy Motor Vehicle Tyre - Rs 375/
- ii) Heavy Motor Vehicle Tube - Rs 75/-
- iii) Light Motor Vehicle Tyre - Rs 150/-
- iv) Light motor Vehicle Tube - Rs 30/-

4. After careful examination, the Government have decided to permit the Director (i/c) Tamil Nadu State Health Transport Department to take action to dispose off the accumulated old tyres and tubes to the approved cooperative societies as per existing norms in force through limited tender process to the best advantage of the Government and it should not be less than the following rates suggested by the Director, (i/c) Tamil Nadu State Health Transport Department.

- i) Heavy Motor Vehicle Tyre - Rs 375/- (Rupees three hundred and seventy five only)
- ii) Heavy Motor Vehicle Tube - Rs 75/- (Rupees seventy five only)
- iii) Light Motor Vehicle Tyre - Rs 150 /-(Rupees One hundred and fifty only)
- iv) Light motor Vehicle Tube - Rs 30/- (Rupees thirty only)

The Director (i/c), Tamil Nadu State Health Transport Department shall ensure that the sale proceeds of the tyres shall be remitted in the appropriate account under intimation to the Government.

5. This order issues with the concurrence of Home(Tr.IV) Department vide its U.O. No. 79672/Tr.IV/2013-1, dated 23.12.2013 and Finance Department vide its U.O. No. 12248/Health-I/2014, dated 05.03.2014.
