ORDER:-

In the Government order first read above, orders were issued for trifurcation of the conduct of both medico legal and non-medico legal postmortem be taken up in the following institutions and also, irrespective of the location of crimes occurring at the Madras Medical College, Madras:-

- (i) Government Stanley Medical College, Madras.
- (ii) Government Kilpauk Medical College, Madras.
- (iii) Government Royapettah Hospital, Madras (attached to Kilpauk Medical College, Madras).

2. In the Government order second read above, among others, orders were issued for amendment to para 633 of Tamil Nadu Medical Code Volume-I for distribution of police stations to Medical Colleges for sending medico-legal cases.

3. In the Government order third read above, among others, orders were issued that a new Government Medical College shall be established at Block-B of the Omandurar Government Estate with an annual intake of 100 students from the academic year 2015-2016.

4. In the Government order fourth read above orders have been issued notifying Government Medical College at Block-B of Omandurar Government Estate, Chennai as a teaching medical institution for the purpose of Anatomy Act.

5. In the letter 4th read above, the Director of Medical Education in her letter has stated that the Medico Legal cases like Post Mortem Examination, Age Estimation, Bone Examination, Sexual offences examination, expert and second opinion cases are being undertaken by all Government Medical Colleges in Tamil Nadu. Medico Legal Case demonstrations are essential for Medical Council of India and the Dr.M.G.R. Medical University norms. So, to fulfill the academic requirement of MBBS Students, starting of medico legal Post-mortem examination and other works mentioned above becomes a necessary entity. Hence, the Director of Medical Education has requested to consider and grant permission to reallocate the Medico Legal Jurisdiction of Chennai towards Government Medical College, Omandurar Government Estate, Chennai-2.

6. In the G.O.(Ms) No.629, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated 27.09.1995 among others, orders were issued distributing police stations to four Government Medical institutions namely Madras Medical College, Stanley Medical College, Kilpauk Medical College and Royapettah Hospital (attached to Kilpauk Medical College).

7. The Director of Medical Education has requested that the police jurisdiction of Government Royapettah Hospital as mentioned in G.O.(Ms) No.629, Health and Family Welfare Department, dated 27.09.1995 can be completely allotted to the New Government Medical College at Block-B of the Omandurar Government Estate, Chennai.

But, Commissioner of Police has suggested that the medico legal jurisdiction of the certain police stations (eight) come under Royapettah Hospital and 2 Police Stations come under the Jurisdiction of Madras Medical College may be allotted to the New Medical College at Block-B of the Omandurar Government Estate and 13 remaining police stations be allowed to continue with Government Royapettah Hospital.

8. Accordingly, the Government direct that the Medico-legal Jurisdiction of the following police stations be allotted to the new Medical College at Omandurar Estate.

9. The Government after careful examination decide to issue the following amendment to Tamil Nadu Medical Code Volume-I.

10. The following amendment shall be issued to para 633 of the Tamil Nadu Medical Code:

Amendment

In the said Tamil Nadu Medical Code Volume-I for the existing para 633 the following para shall be substituted:-

Para 633: Distribution of police stations to Medical Colleges for sending medico legal cases.

With a view to minimize the number of medico legal cases brought by police to the Government General Hospital, Madras and to secure an even distribution of cases proportionate to the staff strength in each institution, all medico legal cases, including prohibition cases, road traffic accidents and cases of postmortem examination on dead bodies in the city of Madras, the Officer-in-charge of the police stations in each group mentioned below, shall arrange to send such cases, to the particular medical institution under which they are grouped.


