ORDER:-

The Director of Medical Education has stated that the Dean, Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai has stated that the existing 8 Nos. of 100 TRS water cooled Chiller of Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai, was installed during 2004 and are functioning with minimal efficiency and due to normal wear and tear, it needs replacement both in structure and functioning. Since the area of AC usage is increasing due to additional procurement of high sensitive Medical Equipments, increase of patients and in order to reduce power consumption, the Director of Medical Education has requested for administrative and financial sanction for an expenditure of Rs.2.97 Crores for renewal of 8 Nos. 100 TRS Air Cooled Screw Type Chiller for Tower Block I and II in Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai 3.

2) The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Medical Education accords administrative and financial sanction for a sum of Rs.2.97 Crores (Rupees Two Crores and ninety seven lakhs only) for renewal of 8 Nos. 100 TRS Air Cooled Screw Type Chiller for Tower Block I and II in Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai 3.

3) The expenditure sanctioned in para 2 above shall be debited under the following Head of Account:

4210 – Capital outlay on Medical and Public Health 01 – Urban Health Services – 110 → Hospitals and Dispensaries (including Pharmacy)
State's Expenditure - JA Buildings – 16 Major Works

“(DPC 4210 – 01 – 110 – JA – 1602)”

4) The expenditure sanctioned in para 2 above shall constitute an item of **“New Instrument of Service”** and the approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by **drawal** of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) is **directed** to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next

Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form "A" appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963, along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (BG-I) Department. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) is requested to send necessary explanatory notes to include the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for the year 2017-18 to Finance (BG-I) Department at the appropriate time without fail.

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
