#### ORDER:

- 2. In the Government letter first read above, the Director of Medical Education was requested to conduct an inspection on the premises of the said institution as per the norms and to furnish their recommendations.
- 3. In his letter second above, the Director of Medical Education has submitted the proposal stating that the said institution has fulfilled the norms prescribed by the Government and recommended to grant permission to the Chairman, Sri K. Ramachandran Naidu Telugu Minorities Educational and Charitable Trust, Paruvakudi Village, Karivalam, Sankarankovil, Tirunelveli District to start two years Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology (DMLT) course at "Sri K. Ramachandran Naidu Medical Lab Technician Course", Paruvakudi Village, Karivalam, Sankarankovil, Tirunelveli District with an annual intake of 15 students from the academic year 2020-2021.

- 4. The Government examined the case in detail in the light of the Inspection Report and the recommendation of the Director of Medical Education and grant permission to the Chairman, Sri K. Ramachandran Naidu Telugu Minorities Educational and Charitable Trust, Paruvakudi Village, Karivalam, Sankarankovil, Tirunelveli District to start two years Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology (DMLT) course with an annual intake of 15 (fifteen) students at "Sri K. Ramachandran Naidu Medical Lab Technician Course" in S.F.Nos.301/3, 303/1&3, 305/1B2 at Paruvakudi Village, Karivalam, Sankarankovil, Tirunelveli District now Tenkasi District 627 753 from the academic year 2020-2021, subject to the following conditions before admitting the students:
  - i. The Trust should obtain the building plan approval from the Directorate of Town and Country Planning.
  - ii. The Trust should obtain the building completion certificate from the competent authority ie. PWD Engineer.
  - iii. The Trust should obtain Clearance Certificate from the State Pollution Control Board.
- 5. The Director of Medical Education is directed to take necessary further action accordingly.
