ORDER:

In Government Order third read above, permission was accorded to the Managing Trustee, V.S. Educational Trust, S.K.S Hospital, Brindavan Road, Salem District to start Diploma in Nursing course with an annual intake of 20 students from the academic year 1993-1994.

2. The Trustee, V.S. Educational Trust, Salem has requested the Government to grant permission for Upgradation of School of Nursing into College of Nursing for 20 seats and to additional intake of 40 seats in B.Sc (Nursing) course in the name and style as "S.K.S. College of Nursing", Alagapuram, Salem.

3. In Government letter seventh read above, the Director of Medical Education was requested to conduct an inspection on the premises of the Trust for considering their request. Accordingly, the Director of Medical Education has constituted an inspection team to verify as to whether the proposed nursing college has fulfilled the conditions prescribed by the Government in the Government Orders first to second and fourth to sixth read above and as per the norms of the Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi.

4. In his letter eighth read above, the Director of Medical Education has submitted the proposal stating that the said institution has fulfilled the norms prescribed by the Government as well as by the Indian Nursing Council and recommended for Upgradation of School of Nursing into College of Nursing for 20 seats and for additional intake of 40 seats in B.Sc (Nursing) course in the name and style as "S.K.S. College of Nursing", Alagapuram, Salem.

5. The Government have examined the case in detail in the light of the Inspection Report and the recommendation of the Director of Medical Education and grant permission to the Trustee, V.S. Educational Trust, Salem for up-gradation of School of Nursing into College of Nursing for 20 seats and for additional intake of 40 seats for B.Sc (Nursing) course ie. total number of 60 (sixty) seats per annum in the name and style as "S.K.S. College of Nursing" in S.F.No. 31, Neikkarapatty Village, Panamarathupatty Panchayat Union, Salem District – 636 010, subject to fulfill the following specific conditions along with other general conditions laid down in G.O (Ms) No.219, Health and Family Welfare (PME.2) Department, dated: 06.06.2018 as applicable to this proposal before admitting the students:-

- i. The Trust should obtain building plan approval for the proposed academic and hostel building from the Directorate of Town and Country and Planning (DTCP).
- ii. The Trust should construct the remaining academic block of 11,142 Sq.ft and hostel block of 22,197 sq.ft within a period one year as mentioned in the undertaking submitted by the Trust.
- iii. The Trust should provide remaining library books and fill up the teaching faculties as per the INC norms.

- iv. The Trust should obtain recognition / affiliation from the Tamil Nadu Nurses and Midwives Council, Chennai and the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University and if needed, suitability from Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi, respectively.

6. The Director of Medical Education is directed to take necessary further action accordingly.
