ORDER:

In the letter first read above, the Director of Medical Education has stated that the Dean, Thanjavur Medical College Hospital, Thanjavur has informed that Tvl.Yercaud Electronics Limited, Chennai is in Annual Maintenance Contract for the EPABX telephone exchange in the above Hospital. The above firm has been requested to inspect the new buildings and submit the estimate for the installation of the telephone extension lines from the EPABX system already available in the old buildings to the new buildings. The firm has deputed their service engineer to inspect the site and they had verified the site with the Resident Medical Officer and Assistant Resident Medical Officer of that hospital. After inspection, it has been identified that totally 87 extension lines are very

essentially required for the new buildings in which all the specialty wards are to be located.

2. The Director of Medical Education has also stated that the Dean, has further stated that the firm has prepared and sent an estimate at the cost of Rs.9,81,140/- (Rupees Nine lakhs Eighty One Thousand One Hundred and Forty only) for the installation of the extension lines to the new blocks. The estimate for the each block is detailed as below:-

1.	For the 300 bedded hospital block	47 extensions	Rs.3,90,230/-
2.	For OP block	23 extensions	Rs.3,42,230/-
3.	Casualty and lab block	17 extensions	Rs.2,48,680/-
		Total	Rs.9,81,140/-

In the Government letter first read above, the Government have decided to incorporate the provision of EPABX system as one of the items to be included alongwith items to be provided under the Hospitals maintenance fund, and also requested to follow the financial procedure for purchase of item under the Hospital maintenance fund. The Director of Medical Education has stated that the Dean has further stated that now an amount of Rs.13,00,000/- (Rupees Thirteen Lakhs only) is available in the Hospital Maintenance fund. The Director of Medical Education has also stated that this proposal does not involve recurring financial commitment.

3. The Director of Medical Education has therefore requested that necessary sanction may be accorded for Rs.9,81,140/- (Rupees Nine Lakhs Eightyone Thousand One Hundred and Forty only) for the undertaking of the above work through M/s.Yercaud Electronics Limited, Chennai.

4. The Government after careful examination has decided to accept the above proposal of the Director of Medical Education and to permit the Director of Medical Education, Chennai-600 010 to undertake the above work through M/s.Yercaud Electronics Limited, Chennai at the cost of Rs.9,81,140/- (Rupees

Nine Lakhs Eighty One Thousand One Hundred and Forty only) by utilizing the Hospital Maintenance Fund of Thanjavur Medical College and Hospital.

5. This orders issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.32771/H.II/14, dated.20.06.2014.
