### ORDER :

Integrated Diseases Surveillance Programme was launched in November 2004 to detect early warning signals of outbreaks of epidemic prone diseases based on which effective Public Health measures could be taken in time. The project period is being extended since then and the project has seen changes in the manpower structures and other components from time to time.

2. In the G.O. first read above, Government sanctioned a pattern of Human Resources Technical and Non-Technical for the project period of five years which includes two post of Data Entry Operators for State Surveillance Unit (SSU) and two District Educational Officers for District Surveillance Unit (DSU) per Revenue District at the rate of Rs.5,000/- PM on contractual basis.

3. In the letter second read above, the Government of India had issued directives, among other technical and non-technical pattern of Human Resources for the placement of only one Data Entry Operator each at State Surveillance Unit and District Surveillance Unit, Premium Institutions on contractual basis and these posts are continued by the approval of appropriation issued in the respective Records of Proceedings of Government of India. The District Surveillance Units are being installed in the Government Medical Colleges in a phased manner. Accordingly, 25 posts of Data Entry Operators have already been filled up by the National Health Mission – Tamil Nadu with monthly contractual salary of Rs.10,000/- p.m with 5% annual increment.

4. In the letter third read above, based on the Record of Proceedings of National Health Mission for the financial year 2019-2020, the Mission Director, National Health Mission has requested the Government to permit him to appoint two Data Entry Operators on outsourcing method at the rate of Rs.10,000/- per month with 5% annual increment for Government Medical College Hospital, Pudukottai and Karur at one per District through District Health Society with Qualification of any degree with one year Diploma in Computer Application with typing knowledge in English and Tamil and also requested to release the funds towards salary of these two posts to the District Health Societies concerned as approved in the RoP 2019-2020 through outsourcing by District Health Society concerned.

5. After careful examination the Government have decided to accept the proposal of the Mission Director, National Health Mission – Tamil Nadu and permission is accorded to Mission Director, National Health Mission to appoint two Data Entry Operators through District Health Society Karur and Pudukottai on outsourcing basis at the rate of Rs.10,000/- per month with 5% annual increment so as to post one each in Karur and Pudukottai Medical College Hospital with a qualification of any degree with one year Diploma in Computer Application with typing knowledge in English and Tamil as per existing norms.

6. The Mission Director, National Health Mission is also permitted to release the funds towards salary of these two posts to the District Health Societies concerned as approved in the RoP 2019-2020 under the FMR code 16.8.2.2.9 on receipt of joining report of the Data Entry Operators appointed through outsourcing by District Health Society concerned.
