Highways Department – Projects – “Construction of Road Over Bridge at Km 0/2 of Kammiyampettai – Kundusalai Road (Major District Road) in lieu of existing Level Crossing No.157 at Railway Km 204/460 in between Varakalpattu and Thirupathiripuliyur Railway Station” — Administrative and Financial Sanction and Change in Nomenclature – Orders – Issued.

ORDER:-

During the budget Demand, the Hon'ble Minister for Public Works, Highways and Minor Ports has announced the following.

“இரயில்வே மேம்பாலைங்கள் எட்டு மாவட்டங்களில் 12 இடங்களில் ரூ.577.27 கோடி மதிப்பீட்டில் கட்டப்படும்.”

2. In the Government Order first read above, the Government accorded administrative sanction for preparation of Detailed Project Report for an amount of Rs.21.30 Lakh for the work of “Construction of Road Over Bridge at Km 0/2 of Kammiyampettai – Kundusalai Road in lieu of existing Level Crossing No.157 at Railway Km 204/460 in between Varakalpattu and Thirupathiripuliyur Railway Station” under Railway Works Programme.

3. In the Letter second read above, the Chief Engineer (projects), Highways Department has stated that due to site constraints and pink book sanction as Road Over Bridge, the alignment for the Road Over Bridge work was approved by the Alignment Committee on 13.05.2015 and the approved Railway General Arrangement Drawing was received from Railways on 31.05.2017. The Combined General Arrangement Drawing was prepared and placed in the Technical Audit Committee meeting held on 06.07.2018 and it was suggested by the committee to study a feasible alternative either Road Over Bridge or Limited Use

Subway instead of Road Over Bridge. Based on the feasibility study, it was decided to provide a Limited Use Subway in place of Road Over Bridge at the Level Crossing 157. The Railways were informed during the Railway Co-ordination meeting held on 19.02.2019 about the finalization of Limited Use Subway at the Level Crossing 157 location and the Railways have accepted the same.

4. The Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department has therefore requested the Government to accord Administrative Sanction for Land Acquisition of 1976 Sq.m. for an amount of Rs.8,49,30,000/-and also to change the nomenclature of the work as "Construction of Limited Use Subway at Km 0/2 of Kammiyampettai – Kundusalai Road (Major District Road) in lieu of existing Level Crossing No.157 at Railway Km 204/460 in between Varakalpattu and Thirupathiripuliyur Railway Stations".

5. The Government, after careful examination, accept the proposal of the Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department and accord Administrative Sanction for Land Acquisition of 1976 Sq.m. for an amount of Rs.8,49,30,000/- and also change the nomenclature of the work as "Construction of Limited Use Subway at Km 0/2 of Kammiyampettai– Kundusalai Road (Major District Road) in lieu of existing Level Crossing No.157 at Railway Km 204/460 in between Varakalpattu and Thirupathiripuliyur Railway Stations", and accord Financial Sanction for a sum of Rs.50,00,000 (Rupees fifty lakh only). The balance amount will be released in subsequent Financial years based on requirement.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para - 5 above shall be debited to the following head of account.

"5054 - Capital outlay on Roads and Bridges – 03. State Highways – 101. Bridges – State's Expenditure – JG Costruction of over and under Bridges in lieu of existing level crossings – 464 Lands – 01. Lands."

7. The Chief Engineer (Projects), Highways Department is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para - 5 above.

8. The expenditure sanctioned in Para 5 above is an item of "New Instrument of Service". The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure may be initially met by drawl of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Chief Engineer (Projects) Highways Department is directed to calculate the actual amount required for the period upto next Supplementary Estimates and apply for sanction of the same as advance from the Contingency Fund to Finance (B.G-I) Department directly in Form 'A' appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with a copy of this order. Orders for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued from Finance (B.G-I) Department. He is also directed to send a draft explanatory notes for including the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2022-2023 to Finance (B.G-I / PW-I) Department without fail.

9. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O. No.35995/Fin (PW-I)/2022, dated 19.07.2022 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.0760 (Seven Hundred and Sixty) (IFHRMS ASL No.2022070760).--
