### ORDER :

In the Government Order first read above, the minimum rates of wages for the employment in cashewnut industry were revised under the provisions of the Minimum Wages Act, 1948 (Central Act XI of 1948).

2. In the Government Order second read above, a Preliminary Notification was issued in order to revise further the minimum rates of wages for the employment in cashewnut industry.

3. The Commissioner of Labour in her letter third read above, has stated that objections and suggestions were received from the persons likely to be affected by such revision which were placed in the Minimum Wages (State) Advisory Board and based on the recommendation of the Minimum Wages (State) Advisory Board, the Commissioner of Labour has requested to confirm the Preliminary Notification issued with the Government Order second read above, with an amendment to the minimum rates of basic wages revised per day for the Classes of work and employees namely Roasting, Borma Worker, Oil Expeller Operator, Tinker and Packer as Rs.240/- instead of Rs.231/- as specified in the Preliminary Notification.

4. The Government have now decided to confirm the Preliminary Notification issued with the Government Order second read above, with an amendment to the

minimum rates of basic wages revised per day for the Classes of work and employees namely Roasting, Borma Worker, Oil Expeller Operator, Tinker and Packer as Rs.240/- instead of Rs.231/-.

5. The appended Notification will, accordingly, be published in the Tamil Nadu Government Gazette both in English and Tamil. The Secretary to Government, Tamil Development and Information Department, Secretariat, Chennai-600 009 is requested to send the Tamil translation of the Notification to the Works Manager, Government Central Press, Chennai-600 079. The Works Manager, Government Central Press, Chennai-600 079 is requested to publish the Notification and send five copies of the Gazette to the Government for reference and record.
