Fundamental Rules – Amendments to FR 22-B based on the Tamil Nadu Revised Pay Rules, 2017 – Orders – Issued.

The following notification shall be published in the **Tamil Nadu Government Gazette:-**

NOTIFICATION.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 read with Article 313 of the Constitution of India and of all other powers hereunto enabling, the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby makes the following amendments to the Fundamental Rules.

2. The amendments hereby made shall be deemed to have come into force on the 1st January, 2016.

AMENDMENTS.

In the said Fundamental Rules, in rule 22-B,-

(1) for the paragraph commencing with the expression "Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules," and ending with the expression "Pay in the Pay band shall be stepped up to the minimum in the higher post", the following paragraph shall be substituted, namely:-

"Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, where a Government servant holding a post in a substantive or officiating capacity, is promoted or appointed in a substantive or officiating capacity, to another post carrying duties and responsibilities of greater importance than those attached to the

post held by him, his initial pay in the level of the higher post in the pay matrix shall be fixed by granting one increment in pay in the level of the lower post and he shall be placed at a cell equal to the pay so arrived at in the level of the higher post in the pay matrix of the higher post, and if no such cell is available in the level of the higher post to which he is promoted, the initial pay shall be fixed at next higher cell in the level of the higher post. However, if the pay so arrived at in the level in the lower post after granting one increment is lower than the minimum pay or the first cell in the level of the higher post, the initial pay shall be fixed at minimum pay or the first cell of the level of higher post.”;

(2) in the third proviso,-

(a) in clause (i), for the expression “pay band”, the expression “level in the pay matrix” shall be substituted;

(b) for clause (ii), the following clause shall be substituted, namely:-

“(ii) for fixation of pay on the date of promotion or appointment to the higher post, initially to draw the next higher pay cell available in the level of the higher post to the pay cell in the level of the lower post and for re-fixation of pay under this rule on the date of accrual of next increment in the lower post, by granting two increments, one accrued on account of annual increment and second on account of promotion, in the level of lower post and his pay shall be fixed at a pay cell equal to the pay so arrived at, in the level of the higher post, in the pay matrix and if no such cell is available in the level of the higher post to which he is promoted, the initial pay shall be fixed at next higher cell in the level of the higher post. Such option shall be exercised within a period of one month from the date of promotion or appointment. The option once exercised shall be final. If no such option is exercised within the said period of one month, the pay shall be fixed in the manner as provided in clause (i) above. If the pay is fixed in the manner as provided in this clause, his next increment shall be allowed on completion of the required qualifying period of one year with effect from the date of re-fixation of pay”.

(3) in the fourth proviso, for the expression “pay band and grade pay” the expression “level in the pay matrix”, shall be substituted.;

(4) in rulings 2(ii) and (6), for the expression “pay band and grade pay” the expression “level in the pay matrix”, shall be substituted.
