ORDER:

The Hon'ble former Chief Minister has made the following announcement on the floor of the Legislative Assembly on 29.08.2016 under Rule 110 :-

In the Letters first read above, Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that in G.O.(Ms) No.14, Environment and Forests(FR.6) Department, dated 04.02.2016, orders have been issued for the implementation of Massive Tree Planting Programme of planting 68 lakh seedlings(60 lakhs seedlings to be planted by Rural Development and Panchayat Raj Department and 8 lakh seedlings to be planted by Forest Department) in commemoration with Hon'ble former Chief Minister's 68th Birth Day under Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme fund.

3. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has also stated that to maintain ecological balance, to increase green cover in rural areas and to mitigate
