ORDER:

In order to encourage the self-reliant attitude of the community and public participation in creation of basic infrastructure in rural and urban area the Government of Tamil Nadu has re-introduced the Self Sufficiency Scheme (SSS) in 2011-2012. Every year funds are allotted and guidelines prescribed by the Government for implementation of the Scheme. In the Government Order second read above, orders were issued for sanction of funds and guidelines prescribed for implementation of the Scheme for the year 2016-2017.

2. In the letter 3rd read above, the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has sent proposals for sanction of funds along with draft guidelines for implementation of the Scheme during the year 2017-2018 and requested orders.

3. The Government has carefully examined the proposal of the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj in detail and issue the following orders :-

- i. Sanction is accorded for a sum of Rs.25.00 Crore (Rupees Twenty Five Crore only) towards implementation of Self Sufficiency Scheme (SSS) during the year 2017-2018.
- ii. Detailed guidelines for implementation of Self Sufficiency Scheme (SSS) during the year 2017-2018 are given in the annexure to this order.

4) The amount sanctioned in para 3(i) above shall be debited to the following head of account:
