### **ORDER:**

In the letter first read above, the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj, has sent a proposal under NABARD-RIDF XXII for laying / upgradation of 187 rural roads and construction of 7 bridges in 8 flood affected districts at an estimated cost of Rs. 150.00 Crore and in the letter second read above Finance Department forwarded the said proposal to NABARD for sanction of loan under NABARD-RIDF XXII.

2) In the letter third read above, the General Manager, NABARD, has informed that the RIDF Project Sanctioning Committee (PSC) of NABARD, among other things has accorded sanction for laying / upgradation of 187 rural roads and Construction of 7 bridges in 8 flood affected districts at an estimated cost of Rs. 150.00 Crore under NABARD-RIDF XXII 2016-17.

3) Consequent to the sanction accorded by the NABARD in the letter 3<sup>rd</sup> read above, the Government, after careful examination, accord administrative sanction for laying / upgradation of 187 rural roads and construction of 7 bridges in 8 flood affected districts of Tamil Nadu at an estimated cost of Rs.150.00 Crore (Rupees One Hundred and Fifty Crore only) with loan assistance from the NABARD under Rural Infrastructure Development Fund-XXII (RIDF-XXII) as annexed to this order. In respect of laying / upgradation of 187 rural roads and construction of 7 bridges at an estimated cost of Rs.150.00 Crore, out of the total Project cost of Rs.150.00 Crore, the NABARD'S loan component would be 80% of the total value and the State Government's share would
