ORDER:

The Hon'ble Chief Minister has made the following announcement under Rule 110 in the Floor of Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly on 13.06.2018:-

“மனவளர்ச்சி குன்றியோர், பார்வைத் திறன் மற்றும் செவித் திறன் குறையுடையோருக்காக செயல்படும் தன்னார்வ தொண்டு நிறுவனங்களில் பணிபுரியும் சிறப்பு ஆசிரியர்கள் மற்றும் தசைப் பயிற்சியாளர்களின் மதிப்பூதியம் 10,000/- ரூபாயிலிருந்து 14,000/- ரூபாயாக உயர்த்தி வழங்கப்படும். இதன் மூலம், 1,129 சிறப்பாசிரியர்கள் மற்றும் பயிற்சியாளர்கள் பயன் பெறுவர். இதனால், அரசுக்கு ஆண்டொன்றிற்கு 5 கோடியே 42 இலட்சம் ரூபாய் செலவு ஏற்படும்”.

2. Based on the above announcement, in the letter read above, the Commissioner for Welfare of the Differently Abled has sent the following details of special educators and therapists working in different centres/schools managed by NGOs which are under the control of the Commissionerate for the Welfare of the Differently Abled, honorarium paid to them at present, additional amount required for the enhanced honorarium under different heads of account:-

He has therefore requested to issue orders on the following:-

- (i) To enhance the honorarium paid to special educators and therapists working in different centres/schools managed by Non-Government Organizations which are under the control of the Commissionerate for the Welfare of the Differently Abled from Rs.10,000/- per month to Rs.14,000/- per month from April 2018 onwards.
- (ii) To sanction an additional amount of Rs.5,41,92,000/- (Rupees Five crore forty one lakh and ninety two thousand only) under relevant head of account in the Revised Estimate 2018-2019 and also permission to incur the amount pending inclusion in the Revised Estimate 2018-2019.

3. After careful examination, the Government have decided to accept the proposal of the Commissioner for Welfare of the Differently Abled and accord sanction to enhance the honorarium paid to 1127 special educators and therapists working in different centres/schools managed by Non Government Organizations from Rs.10,000/- to Rs.14,000/- per month from April 2018 and also accord financial sanction for additional amount of Rs.5,41,92,000/-. (Rupees Five crore forty one lakh and ninety two thousand only)

4. The amount sanctioned in para 3 above, shall be debited under the following heads of accounts:-

5. Necessary additional funds of Rs.5,41,92,000/- will be provided in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2018-2019. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of the Legislature by Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimate 2018-2019. Pending provision of such funds, the Commissioner for Welfare of

the Differently Abled is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 3 above. She is also directed to include this item of expenditure while sending the budget proposal for Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2018-2019 and also send necessary draft explanatory note for inclusion of this expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2018-2019 to Government in Finance (SW/BG.I) Department at the appropriate time without fail.
