ORDER:-

In the Government Order first read above, approval has been accorded to Detailed Project Report for the Extension, Renovation and Modernization of Grand Anicut Canal System at an estimated cost of Rs.2639.15 crore ; and sanction and permission have been accorded to go ahead with tenders for five packages of the project at a cost of Rs.1036.70 crore in order to achieve the requisite state of preparedness so as to go ahead with project negotiation with the Asian Infrastructure Investment Bank.

2. In the letter second read above, the Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai has stated as follows:-

- i) During the 47th GST Council meeting held on 28th& 29th of June 2022 the council had decided to revise the rates of GST for the works contracts supplied to central or state Government from 5% to 12% predominantly for Earthwork excavation and 12% to 18 % for rest of works.

- ii) Subsequently the Government had amended the revision of rates of GST vide G.O. (Ms). No. 114, Commercial Taxes & Registration (B1) Department Dated:22.07.2022 for works contracts supplied to central or state Government with the date of effect as stipulated below:-
- a) Works contract supplied to Central or State Governments, Local authorities for historical monuments, Canals, Dams, Pipelines, Plants for water supply, educational institutions, Hospitals etc., & Sub contract thereof, the rate of GST revised from 12% to 18% with effect from 18.07.2022.
 - b) Works contract supplied to Central or State Governments, Union territories & Local authorities involving predominantly earth work and subcontract thereof, the rate of GST revised from 5% to 12% with effect from 18.07.2022.
- iii) Consequently, the Government in the Letter No. 45114 / Finance (Res-1) / 2022, Finance Department, Dated : 18.12.2022 has directed the respective department to furnish the Revised Administration Sanction with excess over Administration Sanction by only GST after coupling in a single unit proposal with obtaining suitable recommendations from competent committees to the finance department for approval & sanction and also detect the additional funds requirement has been occurred to Government.
- iv) After scrutinizing the Revised Administrative Sanction proposals, it is found that the excess amount occurred due to GST revision implementation only, which could not be accommodated in the Administrative Sanction amount.
- v) By observing the notions and detailed deliberations, the eligible proposals got placed before the 28th meeting of Tender Award Committee held on 23.08.2023 and received approval for sanction, after getting sufficient recommendations and approval from 62nd meeting of Technical Advisory Committee held on 08.08.2023.
- vi) The Revised Administrative Sanction amount approved by the Tender Award Committee is Rs.1082,31,11,494/- with excess amount of Rs.45,61,11,494/- against original Administrative Sanction amount of Rs.1036,70,00,000/-.

3. The Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai has therefore requested the Government to accord Revised Approval to Detailed Project Report for the Extension, Renovation and Modernization of Grand Anicut Canal System at an estimated cost of Rs.2684,76,11,494/- and revised Administrative sanction for an amount of Rs.1082,31,11,494/- for five packages of the project with excess amount of Rs.45,61,11,494/- against original approval to Detailed Project Report of Rs.2639,15,00,000/- and original administrative sanction of Rs.1036,70,00,000/- for five packages respectively.

4. The Government after careful examination have decided to accept the proposal of the Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai and hereby accord Revised Approval to Detailed Project Report for the Extension, Renovation and Modernization of Grand Anicut Canal System at an estimated cost of Rs.2684,76,11,494/- (Rupees Two thousand six hundred eighty four crore seventy six lakhs Eleven thousand four hundred and ninety four only) and revised Administrative sanction for an amount of Rs.1082,31,11,494/- (Rupees One thousand eighty two crore thirty one lakh eleven thousand four hundred and ninety four only) for five packages of the project with excess amount of Rs.45,61,11,494/- against original approval to DPR of Rs.2639,15,00,000/- and original administrative sanction of Rs.1036,70,00,000/- for five packages respectively, as detailed below:-

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall constitute an item of “**New Instrument of Service**” and the approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the legislature, the expenditure will be met by drawl of an advance from the Contingency Fund, Orders regarding which will be issued by Finance (BG-I) Department separately. The Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai is directed to send necessary proposals to Government in Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form ‘A’ appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 with a copy of this order for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund. He is also directed to send necessary explanatory notes for inclusion of the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2023-2024 to Finance (Infrastructure-II/BG-I) Department at an appropriate time.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No.efile/5731/WR1/2023 dated 03.02.2024 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.1845 (One thousand eight hundred and forty five).
