



## **ABSTRACT**

Water Resources Department – Announcement made by the Hon'ble Minister (Water Resources) for 2021 – 2022 -Preparation of Detailed Project Report for desilting of the Gundar and Ramanadhi Reservoirs in Tenkasi District at an estimated cost of Rs.61.36 lakh - Administrative and Financial Sanction accorded - Orders issued.

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### **ORDER:**

During the Demand for Grants for Water Resources Department for the year 2021-2022 held on 23.08.2021, the Hon'ble Minister (Water Resources) on the floor of the Assembly has announced that "This Government will formulate schemes to restore the reservoir capacity for important dams including Mettur, Amaravathi, Vaigai and Pechiparai. Based on this announcement, it is proposed to restore the reservoir capacity of Mettur, Amaravathi, Vaigai, Pechiparai, Gundaru, Ramanadhi, Wellington Dams and Kaverippakkam Tank".

2. Based on the above announcement, the Chief Engineer, Plan Formulation, Water Resources Department has sent a proposal for engaging Consultancy Services for preparation of DPR and related works for desilting of Gundar and Ramanadhi Reservoir in Tenkasi District as follows:-

- (i) A detailed survey on the assessment of quantity of sediments and testing for finding composition of sediments need to be done in the Gundar and Ramanadhi Reservoirs by employing a qualified Consultant to prepare a proper Detailed Project Report.

- (ii) Accordingly, a proposal with estimate for "Consultancy Services for preparation of Detailed Project Report – Topographic surveys, Auger boring for soil analysis including chemical analysis dumping yard surveys, Preparation of Tender document and assistance in evaluation of tenders, Project management consultancy services and performance evaluation study (post project evaluation) for desilting of Gundar and Ramanadhi Reservoirs of Tenkasi District" at an estimated cost of Rs.61.36 lakhs has been received from the Chief Engineer, Madurai Region, Water Resources Department, Madurai.
- (iii) The estimate has been prepared based on the quotation received from M/s.Wapcos Limited who are reputed and qualified consultant in preparing Detailed Project Report for such desilting works.

3. The Chief Engineer, Plan Formulation has requested to accord administrative sanction to engage "Consultancy Services for preparation of Detailed Project Report – Topographic surveys, Auger boring for soil analysis including chemical analysis dumping yard surveys, preparation of Tender document and assistance in evaluation of tenders, Project Management Consultancy Services and Performance Evaluation Study (post project evaluation) for desilting of Gundar and Ramanadhi Reservoirs in Tenkasi District" at a cost of Rs.61.36 Lakh.

4. The Government after careful examination, have decided to accept the above proposal of the Chief Engineer, Plan Formulation, Water Resources Department. Accordingly, administrative and financial sanction is accorded for engaging Consultancy Services for preparation of Detailed Project Report and related works for desilting of Gundar and Ramanathi Reservoirs in Tenkasi District at a cost of Rs.61.36 lakh (Rupees sixty one lakh and thirty six thousand) as detailed below :

The above cost shall be treated as a reference rate only and Consultancy Services shall be selected through proper procurement in line with the existing rules.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

– JI – Investigation of Projects on Surveying and Levelling

6. Necessary additional funds of Rs.61,36,000/- will be provided in Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2022 – 2023. However, this expenditure shall be brought to the notice of legislature by way of Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimate 2022 – 2023. Pending provision of funds, the Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai is authorized to incur the expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above. The Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai is directed to include the above item of expenditure while sending the budget proposal of Revised Estimate / Final Modified Appropriation 2022 – 2023 and also send necessary draft Explanatory Note for inclusion of the expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2022 – 2023 to Finance (PW-II / BG-I) Department at an appropriate time without fail.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No. 38357/PW-II/2022, dated.08.08.2022 and Additional Sanction Ledger No.918 (Nine hundred and eighteen) (IFHRMS ASL No.2022080918).
