Water Resources Department - Revised Administrative Sanction for the work of Construction of a Check Dam across Koundanya River near Sedhukkarai Village in Gudiyatham Taluk of Vellore District at an estimated cost of Rs.11,58,00,000/- – Accorded – Orders issued.

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ORDER:

In the Government Order 1st read above, the Government have accorded administrative sanction for the work of construction of 7 Check Dams in 5 Districts at an estimated cost of Rs.58,32,73,000/- in which the work of Construction of Check Dam across Koundanya River near Sedhukkarai Village in Gudiyatham Taluk of Vellore District at an estimated cost of Rs.7,95,06,000/- is one among them.

2. In the letter 2nd read above, the Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai has sent a proposal for Revised Administrative Sanction for the work of Construction of a Check Dam across Koundanya River near Sedhukkarai Village in Gudiyatham Taluk of Vellore District at an estimated cost of Rs.11,58,00,000/- and furnished the following details:

- i. The Chief Engineer, Water Resources Department, Chennai Region has reported that the Maximum Flood Discharge was considered in the Detailed Project Report as 30255.80 cusecs, whereas during the pre-levels for preparation of estimate, it was observed that the Maximum Flood Discharge for the River at Check dam location found to be 58783 cusecs and hence, the

Superintending Engineer, Upper Palar Basin Circle, Vellore has sought for detailed design from the Superintending Engineer, Designs Circle, Chennai.

- ii. Based on the design, the estimate amount works out to Rs.1158.00 lakh against the Administrative Sanction of Rs.795.06 lakh.
- iii. It is observed that Technical Sanction for the above work has not been accorded yet by the Chief Engineer concerned due to insufficient funds provisions available in the Administrative Sanction and hence, the agency for execution of work could not be finalised.
- iv. The above proposal had been placed before the 38th meeting of Technical Advisory Committee held on 03.01.2023 and the committee had recommended the proposal for Rs.1158.00 lakhs. Subsequently, the above proposal had also been placed before the 21st meeting of Tender Award Committee held on 06.03.2023 and the committee had also recommended the above proposal for Rs.1158.00 lakhs against the Administrative Sanction of Rs.795.06 lakh.

The Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai has requested that Revised Administrative Sanction for the work of Construction of a Check Dam across Koundanya River near Sedhukkarai Village in Gudiyatham Taluk of Vellore District may be obtained for Rs.1158.00 lakh.

4. Based on the recommendations of the Technical Advisory Committee and Tender Award Committee, the Government have decided to accept the proposal of the Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai and accordingly Revised Administrative Sanction is accorded for the work of Construction of a Check Dam across Koundanya River near Sedhukkarai Village in

Gudiyatham Taluk of Vellore District for Rs.1158.00 lakh (Rupees Eleven crore and fifty eight lakh only) with an excess of Rs.362.94 lakh over and above the Administrative Sanction of Rs.795.06 lakh, accorded in G.O (4D) No.76, Water Resources (S1) Department, dated: 10.08.2022.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to the following head of account (40-01):

"4700 - Capital Outlay on Major Irrigation -
03 - Palar Basin - 800 - Other Expenditure State's
Expenditure - DA - Weir - 416 - Major Works -
01 Major Works.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall constitute an item of "New Instrument of Services" and the approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be met by drawal of an advance from the Contingency Fund. The Engineer-In-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai-5, is directed to send necessary proposals to Government in Finance (BG-I) Department directly in Form "A" appended to the Tamil Nadu Contingency Fund Rules, 1963 along with copy of this order for sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund, orders regarding which will be issued by Finance (BG-I) Department separately. He is also directed to send necessary explanatory notes for inclusion of the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimate 2023 - 2024 to Finance (Infra-II / BG-I) Department at an appropriate time.

7. The Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer (General), Water Resources Department, Chennai and the Chief Engineer, Water Resources Department, Chennai Region, Chennai are requested to fix timeline for executing the work and complete the work as before the scheduled time and within the Revised Administrative Sanctioned amount.
