



## ABSTRACT

Tribal Welfare – Grant-in-aid of Rs.20,00,00,000/- released by the Government of India under Central Sector Scheme for Development of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups to Tamilnadu for the financial year 2013-2014 – Implementation of schemes and release of Rs.2000.00 lakhs – Orders – Issued.

### ORDER:-

In the letter first read above, Government of India have requested this Government to prepare a Comprehensive "Conservation-cum-Development Plan for Primitive Tribal Groups" for the next five years of the Twelfth Plan period in the prescribed proforma. Accordingly, the CCD plan for the entire Five years of the Twelfth Five Year Plan had been submitted to Government of India and the same was duly approved by the Government of India.

2. In the Government D.O. letter second read above the proposals had been forwarded to the tune of Rs.2318.25 lakhs for the year 2013-2014 for the Grant –in-aid under the scheme of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups to Government of India for consideration.

3. In the letter third read above, the Government of India have conveyed the sanction of a sum of Rs.2000.00 lakhs under the Central Sector scheme of Development of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups as follows:-

1.	Grant-in-aid for creating capital assets (2013-2014)	Rs.12,00,00,000/-
2.	Grant-in-aid (General) (2013-2014)	Rs. 8,00,00,000/-

4. In the letter fourth read above, as per the suggestion of the Government of India, the Director of Tribal Welfare Government of Tamil Nadu has submitted projects/ activities to be implemented within the sanctioned amount of Rs.2000.00 lakhs for the implementation of welfare schemes to Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups during the year 2013- 2014.

5. The Government, after careful consideration, sanction a sum of Rs.20,00,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty crores only) from the provision of Rs.14,00,00,000/- made in Budget Estimate 2013 -14 along with an additional amount of Rs.6,00,00,000/- for implementing various General / capital works for the Development of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups in the year 2013-14 as detailed in the Annexure to this order.

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 5 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"2225 - Welfare of Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other Backward Classes - 02 - Welfare of Scheduled Tribes - 277- Education - Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan-III Centrally Sponsored - SD - Development of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups - 09 - Grants-in-Aid - 03 Grants for Specific Schemes (DPC 2225 02 277 SD 0933)".

7. Necessary additional funds of Rs.6,00,00,000/- (Rupees six crores only) over and above the provision made in Budget Revised Estimate 2013 - 2014 will be provided in Revised Estimate /Final Modified Appropriation 2013-14. Pending provision of funds in Revised Estimate /Final Modified Appropriation 2013-14, the Director, Tribal Welfare is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 5 above. However, this expenditure will be brought to the notice of the Legislature by Specific Inclusion in the Supplementary Estimate 2013 - 2014. The Director, Tribal Welfare shall include this item of expenditure while sending the proposal for Revised Estimate /Final Modified Appropriation 2013-14 and also send draft explanatory note for inclusion of the expenditure in the supplementary Estimate to Government in Fin (AD&TW /BG-1) Department without fail.

8. The Director of Tribal Welfare is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 5 above to the concerned implementing agencies/authorities.

9. Further, the implementing authorities are directed to advertise about the scheme in local Tamil news papers such as the grant allocated to the scheme and the number of persons/families to be benefited by availing the grant and requested to send a copy of such advertisement to Government /Director of Tribal Welfare for information. The concerned implementing agencies /authorities are also requested to send the progress of the expenditure/ Utilization Certificate for utilizing the amount sanctioned in para 5 above have to be furnished within a period of four months to the Director of Tribal Welfare who will be the overall monitoring authority for the schemes.

10. The Director, Tribal Welfare is also requested to send a monthly progress report about the implementation of the Scheme to the Government in Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare Department.
