ORDER:-

In the D.O. letter first read above, the Government of India has requested this Government to prepare a Comprehensive "Conservation-cum-Development Plan for Primitive Tribal Groups" for the next five years of the Eleventh Plan period in the prescribed proforma. Accordingly, the CCD plan for the entire Five years of the Eleventh Five Year Plan had been submitted to Government of India and the same was duly approved by the Government of India.

2. In the Government D.O. letters second and third read above the proposals to the tune of Rs.740.30 lakhs and Rs.811.640 lakhs prepared based on the CCD plan for Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups have been forwarded to Government of India for consideration and release of funds for the years 2009-10 and 2010-11 respectively.

3. In the G.O. fourth read above, orders have been issued sanctioning a sum of Rs.476.00 lakhs released by the Government of India as first instalment for the year 2010-2011 based on the proposals submitted by the Government in the letter second read above.

4. In the letter fifth read above, the Government have conveyed sanction of a sum of Rs.1075.94 lakhs under the scheme of Development of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups as follows:-

1.	Grant-in-aid for creating capital assets IInd instalment (2009-10)	2,64,30,000/-
2.	Grant-in-aid for creating capital assets (2010-11)	3,10,87,000/-
3.	Grant-in-aid (General) (2010-11)	5,00,77,000/-

5. In the letter sixth read above, as per the suggestion of the Government of India, the Director of Tribal Welfare has submitted projects/ activities to be implemented with the sanctioned amount of Rs.1075.94 lakhs based on the proposals pertaining to the years 2009-10 and 2010-11 for the implementation of welfare schemes to Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups during the year 2011-2012.

6. The Government, after careful examination of the proposals of the Director of Tribal Welfare, accord sanction for a sum of Rs.10,75,94,000/- (Rupees Ten crore Seventy Five lakhs and Ninety four thousand only) for implementing the activities as detailed in the Annexure to this order.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

"2225 Welfare of scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and other Backward Classes - 02 Welfare of Scheduled Tribes 277, Education - Schemes in the Eleventh Five Year Plan-III Centrally Sponsored - SD - Development of Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups - 09 - Grants-in-aid - 03 Grants for Specific Schemes (DPC 2225 02 277 SD 0933)".

8. The Director of Tribal Welfare is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in **para 6** above to the concerned implementing agencies/authorities.

9. Further, the implementing authorities are directed to advertise about the scheme in local news papers such as the grant allocated to the scheme and the numbers of persons/families to be benefited by availing the grant and requested to send a copy of such advertisement to Government /Director of Tribal Welfare for information. The concerned implementing agencies /authorities are also requested to send the progress of the expenditure/ Utilization Certificate for utilizing the amount sanctioned in **para 6** above to the Director of Tribal Welfare who will be the overall monitoring authority for the schemes. A monthly progress report about the implementation of the Scheme should also be sent to the Government in Adi Dravidar and Tribal Welfare Department.

10. Necessary additional funds of Rs.18017 thousands over and above the provisions made in Interim Budget Estimates 2011-12, will be provided in RE/FMA, 2011-12. Pending provision of funds the Director of Tribal Welfare is authorized to draw and disburse the amount. However, this expenditure will be brought to the notice of the Legislature by specific inclusion in the Supplementary Estimates, 2011-12. The Director of Tribal Welfare is requested to send necessary proposals for inclusion of the expenditure in Supplementary Estimates and in RE/FMA, 2011-12.

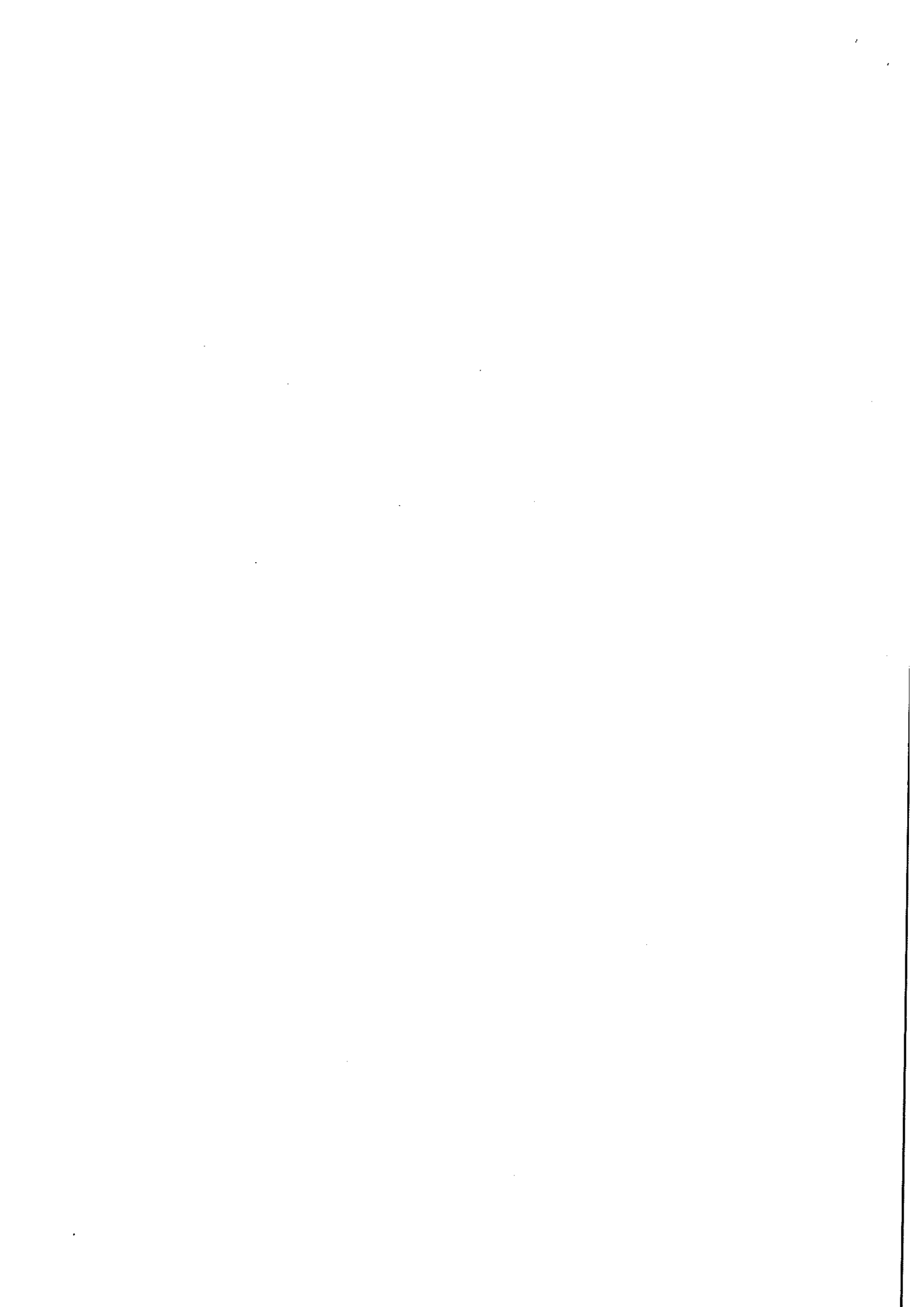
