ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the Government authorized the following thirteen Public Sector /Private Sector Banks, in addition to nine Reserve Bank of India accredited banks, to undertake e-payment of Commercial Taxes:-

2. In the Government Order second read above, the Government authorized 6 Public Sector / Private Sector Banks to undertake e-payment of Commercial Taxes so that the dealers get convenience of more banks for availing of e-payment facility subject to the accreditation of Reserve Bank of India:-

Out of the 19 banks authorized to undertake e-payment of Commercial Taxes Department, the Reserve Bank of India has given accreditation for 15 Banks except Catholic Syrian Bank, Karur Vysya Bank Ltd., YES Bank Ltd. and Tamil Nadu Mercantile Bank Ltd.

3. Based on the willingness given by the Public Sector/Private Sector Banks to take part in e-payment project of Commercial Taxes Department, the Commissioner of Commercial Taxes (full additional charge) has requested the Government to authorise the following 4 (four) more Public Sector/Private Sector Banks to take part in e-payment project of Commercial Taxes Department:-

4. The Government have examined the proposal of the Commissioner of Commercial Taxes (FAC) in para 3 above. In the light of the instructions from Government of India for postponement of liberalization of Government/Agency business arrangement in favour of Private Sector banks for a period of 3 years until a comprehensive review is done by Reserve Bank of India, the Government have decided to authorize the Public Sector bank Viz., Syndicate Bank to undertake e-payment of Commercial Taxes Department.
