PAY REVISION ARREARS -- Mode of payment of 60% arrears consequent on revision of pay of Noon-meal Staff and employees on Fixed pay / Consolidated pay / Honorarium -- Further orders -- Issued.

ORDER :

In the Government Orders read above, among other things, it has been ordered that the 60% of the arrears accruing on account of pay revision in respect of the employees of Noon-meal staff in Fixed pay / Consolidated pay / Honorarium and also on non-standard scales of pay for the period from 1--1--1996 to 31--3--1998 shall be paid in the year 2003--2004 along with interest accrued with effect from 1--4--1998 as admissible to General Provident Fund account.

2) The Government have examined the issue of payment of 60% arrears of pay ordered to the employees of Noon-meal scheme, Fixed pay / Consolidated pay / Honorarium and also employees on Non-standard scales of pay and whose pay revision arrears have not been credited with General Provident Fund account for the period from 1--1--96 to 31--3--98.

3) Accordingly, the Government after careful examination, direct that the balance amount of 60% arrears of pay along with interest arrived upto 31--3--2003 in respect of Noon-meal staff, Anganwadi workers, Helper, Cook and posts on Fixed pay / Consolidated pay / Honorarium be paid in cash during the financial year 2003--2004.

- 4) The expenditure shall be debited to the head of account under which their salary is being drawn. The Budget Estimating Officer will seek the required provisions in R.E. / FMA 2003--2004.
