**PENSION - Dearness Allowance to the pensioners and family pensioners - Revised rate admissible from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2005- Orders - Issued.**

**ORDER:**

In the Government Order read above, orders were issued sanctioning the revised rate of dearness allowance in the pension / family pension to the State Government pensioners/family pensioners as detailed below.

Date from which payable	Revised rate of Dearness Allowance (per month)
<b>With effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2005</b>	<b>64% of pension /family pension</b>

In the said Government Order, orders were also issued sanctioning revised rate of dearness allowance at the rate of 56% with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April, 2005 in the revised ex-gratia amount to the widows and children of the deceased Contributory Provident Fund / Non-pensionable establishment beneficiaries of State Government and the former District Board.

2. The Government have now decided to sanction one additional instalment of dearness allowance at 3% to the pensioners/family pensioners of the State with effect from 1.7.2005. Accordingly, the Government sanction the revised rate of dearness allowance to the State Government pensioners/family pensioners as indicated below:-

Date from which payable	Revised rate of Dearness Allowance (per month)
<b>1<sup>st</sup> July, 2005</b>	<b>67% of pension / family pension</b>

The Government also sanction revised rate of dearness allowance at the rate of 59% with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> July, 2005 in the revised ex-gratia amount to the widows and children of the deceased Contributory Provident Fund / Non-pensionable establishment beneficiaries of State Government and the former District Board.
