ORDER:-

In the order first read above, the Government laid down that the Tamil Nadu Government Advocates on Record, Supreme Court of India, New Delhi should be paid fees for the work done in respect of the Government cases pending in the Supreme Court of India at the rates prescribed in Part-I and II of the second schedule to the Supreme Court Rules 1966. In the G.O. second read above, the Government fixed the rates of fees payable to Tamil Nadu Government Advocates on Record in cases where the Senior Counsels are engaged. The fees have been revised then and there. Lastly in the G.O. 9th read above, the Government revised the fee structure and issued orders fixing the rates of fees payable to the Tamil Nadu Government Advocate on Record, Supreme Court of India, New Delhi for the various types of works.

2. In their letter tenth read above Tamil Nadu Government Advocate on Record, Supreme Court of India have stated that the fees prescribed for appearance before Supreme Court of India by the Tamil Nadu Government Advocates on Record, and related works was fixed in 2001, and requested to revise the fees for different types of works done in connection with the cases pertaining to the Government of Tamil Nadu in Supreme Court of India. They have suggested revision in regard to the fees for different items of works.

3. The Government after careful examination, considering the request of Tamil Nadu Government Advocate on Record, issued orders in eleventh read above for the constitution of miniature committee with the following officers to go into the various aspects of proposals in regard to payment of fees and to suggest suitable recommendations.

Sub : Supreme Court of India - Sanction of fee to Tamil Nadu Government Advocate on Record – Supreme Court of India – expeditious action – Instructions issued.

Ref : 1. G.O. Ms. No.974, Home, Dated 3.10.2001
2. G.O. Ms. No.1096 Home, Dated 21.12.2009.

Orders were issued in G.O. Ms. No.974, Home, Dated 3.10.2001 fixing the rates of fee to Tamil Nadu Government Advocate on Record, Supreme Court of India, for their appearance independently or with Senior Counsels in the Supreme Court of India, on behalf of the Government of Tamil Nadu. Subsequently, orders were issued in G.O.Ms. No. 1096 Home (Courts – IV) Department, dated 21.12.2009 enhancing the above rates of fees.

2. All departments are sending the files to the Department for verification/acceptance/scrutiny of the draft orders for fee sanction to Tamil Nadu Government Advocates on Record, Supreme Court of India. Complaints are received that the fee bill of Tamil Nadu Government Advocates on Record, Supreme Court of India, and Senior Counsels are delayed in settlement.

3. The following instructions are issued so as to avoid the delay in settlement of fee to Tamil Nadu Government Advocate on Record and

Senior Counsels Supreme Court of India. The Departments of Secretariat are requested

- i. To sanction the fees to Tamil Nadu Government Advocate on Record, Supreme Court of India, as per the rates prescribed in the G.Os. indicated in para 1 above without sending the files for remarks/scrutiny/acceptance and verification to Home (Courts - IV) Department.
- ii. If a Senior Advocates are engaged, the fee to Senior Advocate alone need be circulated to Empowered Committee. The fee to Tamil Nadu Government Advocate on Record shall be settled Separately by detaching the fee bills of Advocate on Record first as per rates prescribed in the above G.Os. and to process the file further without delay.
- iii. For sanction of fee to Senior Advocates up to Rs.5,00,000/- per appearance, orders shall be obtained from the Empowered Committee.
- iv. For Sanction of fees to Senior Advocates above RS.5,00,000/- per appearance orders shall be obtained in circulation.
- v. Senior Advocates shall be engaged after obtaining orders in circulation.
- vi. If the Tamil Nadu Government Advocates on Record are engaging in view of urgency, the ratification orders in Circulation shall be obtained.
- vii. Before sanctioning fee to Senior Counsels alone, the file need be sent to Home (Courts - IV) Department so as to make entries in the system.



ORDER:

In the letter sixth read above, the Learned Advocate General of Tamil Nadu has sent a proposal to Government for the revision of fees to the Law Officers.

2. In the Government Order seventh read above, a High Level Committee was constituted to scrutinize the proposal of the Advocate General and to submit report on the revision of Retainer fee and other fees to Law Officers of High Court of Madras and its Bench at Madurai and also to bring in the concept of accountability of Law Officers.

3. Accordingly, the committee, after detailed discussions has submitted its report suggesting recommendations for the Revision of Professional fees to the Law Officers. After careful consideration, the Government have decided to accept the recommendations of the High Level Committee for revising the rates of fees to the Law Officers of High Court of Madras and its Bench at Madurai and accordingly order that the fees payable to the Law Officers of High Court of Madras and its Bench at Madurai be revised as indicated below:-

* The Law Officers namely Government Pleader, Special Government Pleader or Additional Government Pleader, who was incharge of the case should give opinion along with the order copy, either certified copy or Carbon copy specifically indicating the last date for filing appeal or revision, within three days from the date of receipt of the certified / carbon copy of the order.

The competent authority would take a decision for filing appeal or otherwise against the order. Further in deserving cases, the opinion of the Advocate General / Additional Advocate Generals shall be obtained.

(vi) APPEARANCE FEE FOR CRIMINAL SIDE**For Public Prosecutor / Additional Public Prosecutors**

Note: The apportionment of fees between the Public Prosecutor and Additional Public Prosecutors in the Principal Bench as well as in the Madurai Bench shall be in the ratio

of 40 : 60 (40% to the Public Prosecutor and 60% to be shared equally among the Additional Public Prosecutors). The Government Advocates shall be paid lumpsum, the quantum to be decided by the Public Prosecutor from time to time, from the common pool before such apportionment. This payment will be in addition to the retainer fee to the Government Advocates.

(viii) CONVEYANCE ALLOWANCE FOR CIVIL / CRIMINAL SIDE

A sum of Rs.2,000/- per month shall be paid to All Law Officers on Civil and Criminal Side except those who have been provided with Car.

(ix) CELL PHONE CHARGES

The Law Officers those who are not provided with the facility of Cell Phone, the expenditure incurred on Cell Phone charges with an upper limit of Rs.1,000/- per mensem shall be allowed to be reimbursed.

4. Accountability of Law Officers

- (i) The Advocate General / Additional Advocate Generals are requested to hold periodical review meeting once in three months with the concerned Law Officers about the pendency of cases etc., in respect of the departments allotted to them respectively. Similarly, the Special Government Pleader / Additional Government Pleader and other Law Officers shall hold review meetings with the departmental Secretary concerned once in three months and periodical reports shall be sent to Government.
- (ii) Nodal Officers from the Secretariat belonging to each Department shall be nominated to interact with the Law Officers periodically.

5. This order shall take effect from the date of issue of this order and supercedes all the earlier orders issued in respect of payment of fees / Special fees etc. to Law Officers.

6. The expenditure regarding the Retainer fee of the Law Officers shall be debited to the head of account "2014.00 Administration of Justice - 114. Legal Advisors and Counsels- I. Non-Plan-AK. Directorate of Litigation - 33. Payments for Professional and Special Services - 02. Remuneration" (DPC No.2014.00 114 AK 3328).

7. The expenditure on Conveyance Allowance sanctioned in para 3(viii) above shall be debited to the head of account "2014.00. Administration of Justice - 114. Legal Advisors and Counsels- I. Non-Plan - AK. Directorate of Litigation - 01.Salaries - 04. Other Allowances" (DPC 2014.00 114 AK 0143).

8. The expenditure on Reimbursement of Cell Phone charges sanctioned in para 3(ix) above shall be debited to the head of Account "2014.00. Administration of Justice - 114. Legal Advisors and Counsels- I. Non-Plan - AK. Directorate of Litigation- 05.Office Expenses - 01. Telephone Charges" (DPC 2014.00 114 AK 0518).

9. Necessary amendments to Law Officers High Court Standing Order Part-I and Part-II will be issued separately.
