

2) In the Government Order third cited, orders were issued revising the Ordinary Grade scale of pay of Drivers in all Government Departments from Rs.5200—20200 + Grade Pay of Rs.2000 to Rs.5200—20200 + Grade Pay of Rs.2400 notionally with effect from 1—1—2006 and with monetary benefit from 1--3--2011. Clarifications have been sought for by certain Head of Departments as to whether the above revision of scale of pay granted to the Drivers shall apply to the post of the Motor Cycle Messengers.

3) In this connection, I am directed to clarify that the revision of scale of pay granted to the Drivers from Rs.5200—20200 + Grade Pay of Rs.2000 to Rs.5200—20200 + Grade Pay of Rs.2400 in the Government Order third cited shall also be applicable to the post of Motor Cycle Messengers who were also placed on par with the Drivers in the pre-revised scale of pay of Rs.3200—4900. Further, the clarifications issued in respect of Drivers in the Government letters fourth and fifth cited is also applicable in the cases of fixation of pay of Motor Cycle Messengers in the revised Selection Grade / Special Grade scales of pay.
