**Funds – General Provident Fund – Sanction of Temporary advance and part-final withdrawal – Revised orders – Issued.**

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**READ** – the following papers:

G.O.Ms.No.437, Finance (Allowances) Department, Dated: 6.10.1999.

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**ORDER:**

In the Government Order read above, the Government have issued orders reducing the maximum withdrawal of 75% to 60% under special circumstances in respect of Temporary advance / part-final withdrawal from the General Provident Fund.

2) The Government Employees and Teachers Associations have requested to restore the maximum withdrawal of 75% of the balance amount in special circumstances while sanctioning temporary advance / Part Final withdrawal. Hence, the Government have now decided to restore the maximum limit of withdrawal from General Provident Fund to 75%. Accordingly, Government direct that the temporary advance / Part final withdrawal from the General Provident Fund under special circumstances shall be sanctioned to a maximum of 75% of the balance in the account of individual Government Employee under Rule 14(1) (c) (iii) and Rule 15-B(1) of the General Provident Fund (TN) Rules.

3) This order shall take immediate effect.

4) Necessary amendment to the General Provident Fund rules will be issued separately.
