ORDER: -

In the Government Order first read above orders have been issued for the apportionment of seats between Government and self financing / minority / Non-minority Institutions at the rate of 65% and 50% to Post Graduate course for the academic year 2013 – 2014.

2. The Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy in his letter second read above among others, stated that the Registrar, Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University has furnished the seat matrix for admission of candidates to MD (Homoeopathy) Course for the academic year 2013-2014. The MD (Homoeopathy) course is being conducted from the academic year 2010-2011 only in Self Financing Institution namely Saradha Krishna Homoeopathy Medical College, Kulasekaram, Kanniyakumari District. The sanctioned strength for MD (Homoeopathy) course in the above college is 24. This institution is a Minority Institution. Hence 50% of the seats are to be filled up by the Government as per the orders issued in G.O.(Ms)No.13, H&FW Dept, dated 22.01.2013. He has stated that the admission to the above college is to be done by conducting an Entrance Examination for which the prospectus etc., have to be approved by the Government. In this connection, the Registrar, Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University has informed the Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy that, in view of admission made by the said institutions for MD (Homoeopathy) course at their institution for the academic year 2010-2011, 12 seats earmarked for Government quota has to be adjusted 4 seats (one in each speciality) in the academic year 2011-2012, 2012-2013 and 2013-2014, 4 seats have now been adjusted for 2013-2014. Hence he has requested the Government to accord permission for allotment

of candidates under Roaster system of reservation as per G.O.(Ms)No.241, Personnel and Administrative Reforms Department, dated 29.10.1997. He has also sent the draft prospectus, application form, notification etc., for MD (Homoeopathy) Course 2013-2014 for approval and also sought for orders on certain items connected therewith.

3. After careful examination Government approve the Draft Prospectus form and Draft Notification as annexed to this order for the Post Graduate Course in MD (Homoeopathy) 2013-2014 for a total number of 12 seats at 3 each for the Branches being conducted at Saradha Krishna Homoeopathy Medical College, Kulasekaram, Kanniyakumari District as shown below:-

In view of admission made by the said Institution for a MD (Homoeopathy) course at their Institution for the academic year 2010-2011, 12 seats earmarked for Government quota have to be adjusted 4 seats (one in each speciality) have now been adjusted for 2013-2014.

4. The Government also approve the following proposals of Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy in connection with the admission of students for the Post Graduate Course in MD (Homoeopathy) for the academic year 2013-2014.

- i. The cost of application is fixed at Rs.2,000/- (Rupees Two thousand only)
- ii. Applications are issued to candidates through Tamil Nadu Health Department website on par with allopathy side.
- iii. The Entrance Examination will be conducted for 3 hours as in the case of MD (Siddha).
- iv. Candidates belonging to SC/SCA and ST community are exempted from paying the cost of application as per G.O.Ms.No.111/TAWTD/Dept., dated 22.09.1998.

- v. To follow the rule of reservation for filling up of the seats in Post Graduate MD (Homoeopathy) course for the academic year 2013-14 session duly adopting Roaster Method of reservation since each branch has only less than eight seats.
- vi. Minimum eligibility marks for admission are fixed as follow:
For O.C, B.C, B.C(Muslim), M.B.C/DC candidates: 40%
For SC/SCA/ST candidates : 35%
For Service candidates (irrespective of all Communities) : 35%
- vii. The total marks for MD (Homoeopathy) Entrance Examination is fixed as 100 (for Written 90 Marks + Experience = 10 marks).
- viii. The Commissioner of Indian Medicine and Homoeopathy is permitted to publish the MD (Homoeopathy) Entrance Examination 2013 -2014 session results on the day of entrance examination itself.
- ix. The printing work of MD (Homoeopathy) Entrance Examination Question papers should be entrusted to Tamil Nadu Dr.M.G.R. Medical University.
