ORDER:

The Director of Medical Education has stated that 250 to 300 patients are attending the Departments of Hepatology / Surgical Gastroenterology of Madras Medical College/ Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital every day, since Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital is a premier institution in South India and facilities are available in this institution to cater to the need of the downtrodden people. Most of the patients come with Chronic liver diseases and require transplantation of liver. The only treatment for the decompensated liver diseases is liver transplantation. The Madras Medical College / Rajiv Gandhi Government Hospital is having qualified and experienced Medical Officers both in the Departments of Hepatology and Surgical Gastroenterology to carry out the Liver Transplantation Surgery on par with International standards.

2. The Director of Medical Education has therefore requested the Government for administrative sanction, to start Liver Transplantation Unit under the Departments of Hepatology and Surgical Gastroenterology in Madras Medical College / Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai.

3. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education and accord sanction to create a Liver Transplant Unit at Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai to function under the Departments of Hepatology and Surgical Gastroenterology of the Hospital **without any additional staff / expenditure to the Government and manned by the existing staff / funds available in the Department.**


