ORDER:

In the Government order first read above, the Government have accorded Administrative and Financial sanction for a sum of Rs.1,75,00,000/- towards improvement of Post Mortem Block in Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai.

2. The Director of Medical Education has stated that due to tender excess the estimate for construction is Rs.1,82,79,422/-.

3. The Director of Medical Education has therefore requested to accord Revised Administrative Sanction for a sum of Rs.1,82,79,422/- against the original sanction of Rs. 1,75,00,000/-. The Director of Medical Education has forwarded the Revised Estimate prepared by Chief Engineer (Buildings), Chennai Region, Public Works Department, Chennai duly countersigned.

4. The Engineer in Chief and Chief Engineer (Buildings) Public Works Department, Chennai has furnished the following details regarding the revised estimate of Rs.1,82,79,422/-.

The Tender Award Committee, in its 180th meeting on 22.03.2013 has approved the Revised Administrative Sanction proposal for a sum of Rs. 1,82,79,422/- towards the improvement of Post Mortem Block in Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai, subject to accuracy, correctness and genuineness of all informative data furnished by the Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department, Chennai.

6. The Government examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education in detail and accord Revised Administrative and Financial Sanction for a sum of Rs.1,82,79,422/- (Rupees One Crore Eighty Two Lakhs Seventy Nine Thousand Four Hundred and Twenty Two only) towards the improvement of Post Mortem Block in Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai against the original sanction of Rs.1,75,00,000/- (Rupees One Crore and Seventy Five Lakhs only) subject to accuracy, correctness and genuineness of all informative data furnished by the Chief Engineer (Buildings), Public Works Department, Chennai.

7. The expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above shall be debited to the following head of account:-

“4210-Capital Outlay on Medical and Public Health – 01- Urban Health Services – 110 – Hospitals and Dispensaries (Including Pharmacy) – Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan – II State Plan – JA Buildings – 16 Major Works” (D.P.Code 4210-01-110-JA-1602)”.

8. Necessary additional funds will be provided in RE/FMA 2014-15 to meet the expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above, pending provision of funds in RE/FMA 2014-15, the Chief Engineer (Buildings) is authorized to draw and incur the expenditure and he is requested to include the expenditure sanctioned above, while sending the Budget proposal for Revised Estimates /Final Modification Appropriation 2014-15 to Government in Finance Department without fail.
