ORDER:-

The Director of Medical Education has stated that the Dean, Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai has forwarded the proposal and requested to sanction the following posts for the department of Rheumatology.

2. The Director of Medical Education has also stated that the Professor and Head of the Department has stated that there is critical shortage of the above cadres of paramedical and laboratory personnel in the department and it is very difficult to cater to the needs of patients who are in vast numbers as that is the only full-fledged department in the whole of Tamil Nadu. The existing posts were sanctioned nearly forty years ago when the department was started and the work has increased ten folds now, including the number of patients. The out patient census is around 1 lakhs per year and inpatient census, is around 1500 per year. Every day is admission day in the department hence the turnover of patients is very high. Many cases come for cyclical specialized Chemotherapy protocols which require infusions are started in the morning and continue till evening. Further special clinics are functioning e.g., Lupus clinic, where a large number of patients attend.

3. The Director of Medical Education has therefore requested the Government to sanction the 39 para medical posts mentioned above to the Department of Rheumatology, Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai.

4. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education in detail and accord sanction for creation of 39 para medical posts in various categories to the Department of Rheumatology, Rajiv Gandhi Government General Hospital, Chennai at an annual average recurring cost of Rs.2,00,01,240/- (Rupees Two Crore One Thousand Two Hundred and Forty only) in the time scale of pay as detailed below:-

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above, shall be debited to the following head of account:

6. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall constitute an item of “New Instrument of Service”. The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund. Orders regarding the sanction of advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued by the Finance (BG.I) Department separately. The Director of Medical Education is requested to send necessary proposals to Government in Finance (BG.I) Department in the prescribed format along with a copy of this order to sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund. She is also requested to send a draft explanatory notes for inclusion of the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates 2014-2015 to Finance (BG.I) Department at the appropriate time without fail.


