ORDER:

In order to tide over the crisis of dearth of teaching staff in Government Medical Colleges, the Director of Medical Education has constituted, at the instance of the Government, a committee consisting of Director of Medical Education, Dean, Madras Medical College, Chennai, Dean, in-charge, Stanley Medical College, Chennai, Principal, Tamil Nadu Government Dental College & Hospital, Chennai, Deputy Director of Medical Education (A& R) and Deputy Director of Medical Education (P &D).

2. Based on the report of the above committee, the Director of Medical Education has submitted the proposal (Phase I) relating to recruitment of Non-Clinical Teachers with Post Graduate qualified doctors and Post Graduate qualified Non-Medical personnel. She has stated that as on date 594 vacancies are available in the Non – Clinical Departments of various Government Medical Colleges in the State. As the Medical Council of India has already started inspecting the existing Medical colleges and likely to start the renewal inspection in the new colleges from December 2007 onwards, she has requested necessary permission for recruitment of non clinical faculty in the 594 vacancies in various Government Medical Colleges by adopting the following modalities:-

- (i) Medical officers exclusively for the Non – Clinical Departments may be appointed temporarily in the regular time scale.
- (ii) The Medical Officers who are to be appointed for the said posts should possess a Post Graduate Degree in the faculty concerned.
- (iii) The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine will give an appointment order to the qualified Non – Clinical Doctors as "Appointed as Tutors in the Medical Colleges under the control of Director of Medical Education"

- (iv) The Director of Medical Education will give posting order as Tutor or Assistant Professor after assessing their eligibility for the said posts in accordance with the Medical Council of India Norms.
- (v) While giving posting orders, if he / she requests for any particular College, it will be considered without prejudice to the existing vacancy. If necessary, the qualified newly recruited Medical Officers may be accommodated by shifting, the unqualified Medical Officer working in the department concerned.
- (vi) Simultaneously the Director of Medical Education will address the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine for appointment of Non - Medical Tutors with M.Sc., Medical qualification as Tutors in Non - Clinical Departments temporarily in the regular time - scale.
- (vii) As per the Medical Council of India Norms, in each Medical College, in each Non - Clinical Department 30 % of Tutor posts will be filled up with Non - Medical. In the Department of Bio - Chemistry, 50 % of the posts will be filled up with Non - Medical Tutors.
- (viii) If there are no adequate number of doctors with Non - clinical degree and Non - Medical personnel registered with the Employment Exchange, the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine shall address the Commissioner of Employment and Training for "**No Objection Certificate**" so as to organize Walk - in - Interview by applying all Rules and Regulations in practice.
- (ix) After obtaining No Objection Certificate from Employment Exchange a Committee consisting of the Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine, the Director of Medical Education and a representative of the Secretary to Government, Health and Family Welfare Department will recruit qualified doctors with Non - Clinical degree and non - medical personnel, by giving announcement through all Media.
- (x) The above said recruitment will be made for all existing Medical Colleges and 3 new Medical Colleges proposed to start.

3. The Government have examined the proposal and decided to permit the Director of Medical Education to fill up the 594 vacancies in the Non-Clinical Departments of various Government Medical Colleges in the State temporarily in the time scale of pay of Rs. 8000- 275-13500 in relaxation of rule 10 (a) (i) of the General Rules for Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services, by following the modalities mentioned in para 2 above subject to the condition that the individuals shall be terminated from service as and when the candidates selected by the Tamil Nadu Public Service Commission join duty.

4. Accordingly, in exercise of the powers conferred under rule 48 of the General Rules for Tamil Nadu State and Subordinate Services contained in Part II of Volume - I of the Tamil Nadu Services Manual 1987, the Government of Tamil Nadu hereby relaxes the rule 10 (a) (1) of the General Rules, so as to appoint the Non - Clinical Medical Officers temporarily in the Tamil Nadu Medical Service in the time scale of pay of Rs. 8000 -275-13500.

5. The Director of Public Health and Preventive Medicine is directed to obtain the seniority list of doctors registered in the employment Exchange at the ratio of 1: 5 for filling up the above vacancies of Medical Officers in the Tamil Nadu Medical Service.
