1. Announcement of Hon'ble Minister (Health) held on during the Budget Session 2012-2013 in demand No.19.
2. From the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Society Letter Ref. No.7066/HSP/TN-EMRI/12, Dated. 20/09/2012 and 21.6.2013.

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ORDER:

The Hon'ble Minister (Health) has announced during the Budget Session 2012 – 2013 that “208 number of Ambulance will be purchased in the place of recommended condemned vehicles.”

2 The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Project in the reference second read above has stated that 208 no. of Ambulances (154 under Director of Medical and Rural Health Services and 54 under Director of Medical Education) may be procured in the place of recommended condemned vehicles at a cost of Rs.28.00 Crores.

3. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Project has also furnished the estimated cost for the procurement of 208 ambulances at a cost of Rs.28.00 Crores as detailed below:-

4. The Government have examined the proposal and decided to accept it with restrict the number of vehicle from 208 to 116. Accordingly issue the following orders:-

- i) Sanction is accorded to procure 116 no. of Ambulance vehicle in lieu of condemned vehicles for the use of 108 fleet expansion replacement of existing old vehicles at an estimated cost of Rs. 15,19,60,000 (Rupees Fifteen Crores Nineteen Lakhs and Sixty Thousand only) as detailed below:-

- ii) 116 new ambulance procured being used for 108 fleet expansion / replacement of 108 (existing old vehicles) instead of 208 ambulance.
- iii) the deployment in institutions / remaining vehicle / being done strictly based on the patient turnover.
- iv) there being no recruitment against vacant posts since 108 EMRI will be recruiting trained drivers for the new vehicles.
- v) the vehicles deployed in institution being taken care of by redeployment of drivers.
- iv) the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Project is authorized to procure 116 Nos. of Ambulance vehicles The Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Medical Service Corporation will be made the procurement process and supply the vehicle.

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 4 above shall be debited to following head of account:-

"2210-Medical and Public Health – 01 Urban Health Services – Allopathy - 110 – Hospitals and Dispensaries Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan – II – State Plan – PB – Procurement through Tamil Nadu Medical Service Corporation for secondary care facilities – 21 Motor Vehicles – 01 Purchase (DPC.: 2210-01-110-PB-2116)

6. Necessary funds will be provided in RE/FMA/2013-14. Pending provision of funds the Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Project is authorized to draw and utilize the amount sanctioned in para 5 above. However, this expenditure will be brought to the notice of the legislature by specific inclusion in the supplementary estimate 2013-2014. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health System Project, Chennai is directed to include this item of expenditure while sending the proposal for RE/FMA 2013-14 and send necessary draft explanatory notes for inclusion of expenditure in Supplementary Estimates, to the Government in Finance Department without fail.

7. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.34434/Health-II/2013, dated 5.07.2013 and ASL No.565 (Five hundred and sixty five).
