ORDER:

A major fire incident occurred in Virudhunagar District on 4.9.2012 and a lot of lives were lost. In order to provide better medical facilities for the patients suffering from fire injuries in and around Sivakasi, the Hon'ble Chief Minister has announced among others, that the Government will upgrade the Burns Ward as Centre of Excellence in Government Hospital, Sivakasi at a cost of Rs.4.50 crores. The above Centre of Excellence will consist the following facilities:-

- * Intensive Care Unit (ICU)
- * Operation theatre
- * Plastic Surgery Unit
- * Orthopedic Unit
- * Physiotherapy Unit
- * Rehabilitation Centre
- * Additional 30 beds

2. The break up details of Rs.4.50 crores are as follows:

3. Accordingly the Government accord sanction to upgrade the Burns Ward at Government Hospital, Sivakasi, Virudhunagar District as Centre of Excellence and to sanction a sum of Rs.4.50 crores (Rupees Four crores and fifty lakhs only) as follows:

- i) to incur a sum of Rs.2.25 crores (Rupees Two crores and twenty five lakhs only) towards construction of new buildings and renovation of existing buildings.
- ii) for creation of additional 24 posts (at a recurring cost of Rs.1.50 crores (Rupees One crore and fifty lakhs only) per annum) as mentioned in the Annexure to this order.
- iii) to incur a sum of Rs.50.00 lakhs (Rupees Fifty lakhs only) towards purchase of equipments.
- iv) to incur a sum of Rs.25.00 lakhs (Rupees Twenty five lakhs only) towards purchase of furniture, stores and linen.

4. The expenditure sanctioned in para-3 (i) above shall be debited to the following head of account

"4210-Capital Outlay on Medical and Public Health - 01 Urban Health Services – 110 Hospital and Dispensaries (including pharmacy) – Schemes in the Twelfth Five year plan-II. State plan – JA – Buildings – 16. Major Works" (DPC 4210 01 110 JA 1602) - (Rs 2.25 crores)

5. The expenditure sanctioned in para 3 (ii) to (iv) above shall be debited to the following head of account:

"2210 - Medical and Public Health- 01 Urban Health Services – Allopathy – 110 Hospitals and Dispensaries – I Non-Plan AB Taluk Headquarters Hospitals – 01 Salaries (DPC 2210 01 110 AB 0104) – (Rs.1.50 crores)

05 Office expenses – 05 Furniture

(DPC 2210 01 110 AB 0551) (Rs. 10.00 lakhs)

19 Machinery and Equipments. 01 – Purchase

(DPC 2210 01 110 AB 1916) (Rs. 50.00 lakhs)

46 Clothing, Tentage and Stores

(DPC 2210 01 110 AB 4600) (Rs. 5.00 lakhs)

47 Stores and Equipments 01 Stores

6. The amount sanctioned towards purchase of equipments shall not be paid in cash but credited to the following Personal Deposit Account:-

K Deposit and Advances (b) Deposits not bearing Interest 8443.00 Civil Deposits – 800 – Other Deposits – CE – Deposits of Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation (DPC 8443-00-800-CE-000 H (Receipts).

By means of a Cheque / Demand Draft in favour of the Personal Deposit Account of the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation Limited.

7. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is authorized to draw and deposit the amount sanctioned in para 3 (iii) above to the Personal Deposit Account of the Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation, Chennai.

The Chief Engineer (Buildings) Public Works Department is authorized to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 3 (i) above.

8. The expenditure sanctioned above shall constitute an item of "New Service" and the approval of Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending Approval of Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by an advance from the contingency Fund and orders regarding the sanction of advance from the Contingency Fund will be issued by Government in Finance (BGI) Department separately. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) Public Works Department/ Director of Medical and Rural Health Services are requested to apply in the prescribed format for sanction of Contingency Fund to Finance (BGI) Department. The Chief Engineer (Buildings) Public Works Department/ Director of Medical and Rural Health Services are also directed to send necessary explanatory notes for inclusion of the expenditure in the supplementary estimate for 2012-13 to obtain the approval of the Legislature at the appropriate stage.

9. The Government also direct the above Centre of Excellence shall function under the technical supervision and control of Medical Superintendent, Government Rajaji Hospital, Madurai.

10. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services shall be the Budget estimating and controlling officer to the above Centre of Excellence and he is hereby authorized and permitted to draw all kinds of bills related to the Centre of Excellence at Government Hospital, Sivakasi, Virudhunagar District now sanctioned.

11. The Chairman/Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Medical Services Corporation is authorized to supply all the Equipments on receipt of the requirements as and when requested by the concerned incharge Medical Officer of the Centre of Excellence at Government Hospital, Sivakasi, Virudhunagar District according to rules in force.

12. The Director of Medical and Rural Health Services is directed to obtain the plan and estimate for the civil works sanctioned above from the Engineer-in-Chief and Chief Engineer, Chennai Region, Public Works Department within 15 days.

13. The Project Director, Tamil Nadu Health Systems Project is directed to supervise and implement the above project for establishing the Centre of Excellence at Government Hospital, Sivakasi in coordination with the Director of

Medical and Rural Health Services and the Public Works Department and ensure that the project is completed within a period of six months.
