ORDER:

In her letter second read above, the Director of Medical Education has stated that a survey was conducted by the Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board and they have stated that there is no possibility of new bore wells in the premises of Tirunelveli Medical College and 7 bore wells are already dried up. At present the hospital has 1400 beds and 6,82,500 liters of water supply is needed per day. Therefore, the water supply could not be properly maintained to the need of patients in the hospital and the water supply to the Hospital by the Tirunelveli Corporation is inadequate for the total use of the Hospital.

2. The Director of Medical Education has also stated that the Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board had submitted a project to have direct water supply from Tamirabarani river. The Dean, Tirunelveli Medical College Hospital, Tirunelveli had paid a sum of Rs.4.80 lakhs to the Executive Engineer, Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board, Project Division, Tirunelveli towards investigation charges. The Chief Engineer, Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board has submitted the estimate for a sum of Rs.655 lakhs towards project cost for supply of water to Tirunelveli Medical College Hospital, Tirunelveli and has requested to pay the amount in one installment.

3. In the Government Order first read above, orders have been issued ratifying the action of the Managing Director, Tamil Nadu Water Supply and Drainage Board in having prepared the project proposal and for having done the investigation works as 100% deposit work from the funds of Rs.4.80 lakhs provided by the Dean, Tirunelveli Medical College Hospital, Tirunelveli towards supply of water to Tirunelveli Medical College Hospital from Tamiraparani river.

4. In his letter third read above, the District Collector, Tirunelveli has accorded permission to draw water from Tamirabarani river to the Tirunelveli Medical College and Hospital and has furnished the track rent towards laying of pipe lines and the Chief Engineer, Water Resources Organization, Public Works Department, Madurai Region has stated that no separate order is necessary for permitting to drawl of water from Thamirabarani river. The details of track rent as per G.O.(Ms) No.202, Revenue Department, dated:24.2.2000 and the cost as furnished by the District Collector, Tirunelveli are as follows:-

5. The Director of Medical Education has therefore requested the Government to accord sanction for a sum of Rs.655 lakhs towards the project cost and Rs.12.37 lakhs per annum as maintenance charges of the above.

6. The Government have examined the proposal of the Director of Medical Education and accord financial sanction for a sum of Rs.655.00 lakhs (Rupees six crores and fifty five lakhs only) towards the project cost for supplying water directly from Tamirabarani river to Tirunelveli Medical College and Hospital, Tirunelveli and a sum of Rs.12.37 lakhs (Rupees twelve lakhs and thirty seven thousand only) per annum towards maintenance charges of the project.

7 (i). The expenditure sanctioned towards maintenance charges shall be debited to the following Head of Account:-

"2210-Medical and Public Health -01-Urban Health Services Allopathy – 110 – Hospital and Dispensaries -1-Non Plan-DH- Tirunelveli Medical College Hospital, Tirunelveli 18 Maintenance – 01 periodical maintenance. (DP Code 2210-01-110-DH-1813)."

(ii). The expenditure towards project cost shall be debited to the following new Head of Account opened under Demand No.19.03:-

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"4210 – Capital Outlay on Medical and Public Health – 80 General – 800 – Other expenditure – Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan-II – State Plan-JF – Construction/Improvement works to Medical College Hospitals, Other Hospitals and Dispensaries – 16 – Major Works. (DPC 4210-80-800-JF-1604)."

8. The Director of Medical Education is the estimating, reconciling and controlling authority for the new head of account opened in para 7(ii) above. The Pay and Accounts Office/Treasury Office concerned are requested to open the above new sub-head in their books.

9. The expenditure sanctioned in para 6 above constitutes on item of "New Service". The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course, pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by drawl of an advance from contingency fund, orders regarding which will be issued by Finance (BG-I) Department separately. The Director of Medical Education is requested to send necessary proposals to Government in Finance (BG-I) Department in prescribed format along with a copy of this order for sanction of an advance from the contingency fund. He is also requested to send necessary explanatory rates for inclusion of the above expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates to Finance (BG-I) Department at the appropriate time.

10. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No.59113/H-II/2012, dated: 29.10.2012 and ASL No.1399 (One thousand three hundred and ninety nine.)
