ORDER:

In the circumstances reported by the Additional Director of Medical Education / Secretary, Selection Committee in his letter read above and after careful examination of his request Government have decided to incorporate a clause under Eligibility Criteria in the Policy / Prospectus for admission to MBBS / BDS Course from the year 2013 -14.

2. Accordingly Government order that "the candidates who possess dual citizenship obtained through appropriate authority viz. the Government of India, are eligible for admission in Medical Colleges subject to the condition that they should produce valid permission from Government of India viz. Overseas Citizens of India card to treat them on par with Indian Citizens" and only those who are registered under section 7 A of the Citizenship Act, 1955 (Central Act 57 of 1955) are eligible to apply for MBBS / BDS courses in the State subject to the production of proof of such registration".

3. The Additional Director of Medical Education / Secretary, Selection Committee is directed to take action accordingly.
