ORDER

Every year, 30% rebate on sale of khadi cotton varieties and 20% rebate on sale of khadi silk varieties are provided to encourage the sale of khadi products. This took into account the rebate allowed by the Khadi and Village Industries Commission, Mumbai as detailed below:-

In the Government Order second read above, orders were issued to allow State Government rebate at 20% on sale of khadi cotton, polyvastra and khadi silk for the month of April 2010, as guidelines on rebate has not been received from the Khadi and Village Industries Commission for the financial year 2010-2011.

3. The Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Khadi and Village Industries Board in her letters third read above has stated that, the Market Development Assistance (MDA) guidelines are in receipt from the Khadi and Village Industries

Commission. These guidelines make a departure from the usual policy on rebate of the Government of India. It may therefore take some time to examine the guidelines for finalizing the State Government's rebate policy for this year and the coming years. The Board of Management of the Khadi and Village Industries Board had been requested to give its recommendations in this regard. The Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Khadi and Village Industries Board in her letter cited third in the reference above has requested the Government to allow 20% rebate on sale of Khadi Cotton, Polyvastra Cotton and Khadi Silk varieties for further period of May and June 2010, so as to enable the Board / Certified institutions to continue the sales without affecting the customers and also to give continuous employment to spinners and weavers.

4. The Government have examined the proposal of the Chief Executive Officer, Tamil Nadu Khadi and Village Industries Board carefully and order that the State Government rebate be allowed at 20% on sale of Khadi cotton and 10% on sale of khadi silk upto 30.06.2010, since budget provisions are already available.

5. This order issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O.No. 88/SS (RT)/2010 dated 24.5.2010
