4) The Government, after careful consideration, accept the request of the Director of Handlooms and Textiles and sanction a sum of Rs.54,10,310/- (Rupees Fifty four lakhs Ten thousand three hundred and ten only) (GOI share of Rs.45,73,790/- + GOTN share of Rs.8,36,520/-) towards second instalment for grant component for implementation of 4 Handloom Cluster Development Programmes (Phase-VI) under the Integrated Handloom Development Scheme for the year 2010 - 2011.
