Sericulture - Installation of upgraded Multi-end Silk Reeling Machines in the Government Silk Reeling Units, Construction of a building for Directorate of Sericulture at Salem, Construction of additional training halls and hostel building for Tamil Nadu Sericulture Training Institute, Hosur - Funds sanctioned - Orders - Issued.

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### **ORDER:**

The Hon'ble Chief Minister of Tamil Nadu has made the following announcements under Rule 110, of the Tamil Nadu Legislative Assembly Rules pertaining to the Department of Sericulture on 08.05.2013:-

- a. Implementation of new scheme, "One Sericulture Farmer" in Every Panchayat Village".
- b. Establishment of 50 Farm Ponds during the year 2013-2014 in Government Silk Farms.
- c. Installation of upgraded Multi-end Silk Reeling Machine in 8 Government Silk Reeling Units.
- d. Construction of building for the Directorate of Sericulture at Salem.
- e. Construction of additional Training Halls and Hostel Building for Tamil Nadu Sericulture Training Institute at Hosur.

2. In the letter read above, the Chief Conservator of Forests and Director of Sericulture has stated that in-respect of items (a) and (b) mentioned in para 1 above there is no financial involvement and hence no additional fund is required for the implementation of these announcements. In-respect of implementation of items (c), (d) and (e),

mentioned in para 1 above, a sum of Rs.345.00 lakhs is required as detailed below:-

- i. A sum of Rs.80.00 lakhs is required for the Installation of upgraded Multi-end Silk Reeling Machines in the Government Silk Reeling Units located at Hosur, Vaniyambadi, Salem, Talavadi, Pudukottai, Sivagangai, Nannagaram (Tenkasi) and Nagercoil.
- ii. A sum of Rs.165.00 lakhs is required for the construction of a building for the Directorate of Sericulture, Salem. And,
- iii. A sum of Rs.200.00 lakhs is required for the construction of additional training halls and hostel building for Tamil Nadu Sericulture Training Institute, Hosur. Out of this, Rs.100.00 lakhs will be borne by Tamil Nadu Sericulture Training Institute, Hosur. Hence, Rs.100.00 lakhs is required from the State Government.

3. The Government after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Sericulture have decided to accept it and sanction is hereby accorded for a sum of Rs.345.00 lakhs (Rupees three crore and forty five lakhs only) for implementing the schemes as detailed in para 2 above.

4. The amount sanctioned in para 3 above, shall be debited to the following Heads of Account:-

**(a) Installation of upgraded Multi-end Silk Reeling Machines – Rs.80.00 lakhs.**

“2851-00 Village and Small Industries – 107. Sericulture Industries – Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan – II. State – Plan – LF. Direction and Administration – 19. Machinery and Equipments – 01. Purchase.”

**(b) Construction - Rs.265.00 lakhs (Rs.165 lakhs for construction of building for Directorate + Rs.100 lakhs for training/ hostel buildings at Tamil Nadu Sericulture Training Institute, Hosur)**

The expenditure may be debited under the new Capital head of account opened under Demand No.18-02 as detailed below:-

“4851.00 Capital Outlay on Village and Small Industries – 107. Sericulture Industries – Schemes in the Twelfth Five Year Plan-II. State Plan- KE – Directorate of Sericulture – 16. Major Works”.

5. The Chief Conservator of Forests and Director of Sericulture is the estimating, reconciling and controlling authority for the above new capital head of account.

6. The Pay and Accounts Officer / Treasury Officer concerned is directed to open the above new capital head in their books of account.

7. The expenditure is an item of "New instrument of Service". The approval of the Legislature will be obtained in due course. Pending approval of the Legislature, the expenditure will be initially met by sanction of an advance from the Contingency Fund, orders regarding which will be issued by the Government in Finance (BG.I) Department. The Chief Conservator of Forests and Director of Sericulture is directed to send necessary proposals to Government in Finance (BG.I) Department, in the prescribed format along with a copy of this order for sanction of an advance required for the current year from Contingency Fund. He is also directed to send a draft explanatory note, indicating the total cost of the scheme, the cost that would be required for the implementation during the financial year etc. to Government in Finance (BG.I) Department, for inclusion of the expenditure in the Supplementary Estimates for bringing it to the notice of the Legislature, in due course.

8. The Chief Conservator of Forests and Director of Sericulture is authorised to draw and disburse the amount sanctioned in para 3 above.

9. This orders issues with the concurrence of Finance Department vide its U.O. No.49390/Ind/ 2013, dated 19.09.2013 and ASL No.1291 (One thousand two hundred and ninety one).
