ORDER:

In the Government order first read above, Government have introduced various Subsidy Schemes for all New Micro, Small and Medium Manufacturing Enterprises in Tamilnadu. The time limit for filing their application for Capital Subsidy / Special Capital Subsidy / Additional Capital Subsidy for select category of Entrepreneurs / Employment intensive subsidy / Issue of Eligibility Certificate for availing Subsidy on Value Added Tax / reimbursement of Stamp duty applications and Additional Capital Subsidy for promotion of clean and environment friendly technologies, prescribed in the G.O. 1st cited, is presently 6 months from the date of commencement of commercial production.

2. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce, in his letter second read above, has stated that various Industries associations have represented for extending this time limit for filing their subsidy application from 6 months to one year. Based on these representations, the Hon'ble Minister for Rural Industries and Animal Husbandry while moving the demand for Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises Department for the year 2010-2011 in the Legislative Assembly on 21.04.2010, made an announcement for extending the time limit for filing their subsidy applications from 6 months to one year.

3. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce has, therefore, requested the Government to amend Paras No. 5.3.i, 5.3.ii, 12.4 and 13.4 of the Guidelines to Micro, Small and Medium Industries Policy 2008 issued in the Government order first read above replacing the words “6 months” with “one year”.

4. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce has also requested to extend the outer time limit for condonation of delay in filing of applications from “one year” to “one year and six months” by issuing necessary amendment to para 5.5 of the guidelines to Micro, Small and Medium Industries Policy 2008.

5. The Government, after careful examination, have decided to accept the proposal of the Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce in paras 3 and 4 above and issue the following amendments to the Guidelines to Micro, Small and Medium Industries Policy 2008 issued in the Government Order first read above:-

AMENDMENTS

- a) For the expression “Within 6 months” occurring in paras 5.3.i, 5.3.ii, 12.4 and 13.4 of the guidelines to Micro, Small and Medium Industries Policy 2008, the expression “Within **one year**” shall be substituted.
- b) For the expression “does not exceed one year from the date of commencement of commercial production” occurring in para 5.5 of the Guidelines to Micro, Small and Medium Industries Policy 2008, the expression “does not exceed **one year and six months** from the date of commencement of commercial production” shall be substituted.

6. This order shall take effect from 21.04.2010.
