ORDER:

The Government, in the order first read above, approved Micro, Small and Medium Industries Policy 2008 and the Guidelines for Administration of Incentives and Concessions in the Policy.

2. The Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce in the reference second read above, has sent proposal for amending the Micro, Small and Medium Industries Policy, 2008 and the Guidelines announced in the Government order first read above for including the schemes of “National Equity Fund Scheme (Renamed as Micro / Small Enterprises Funding Scheme) and Credit Guarantee Fund Trust Scheme in para 6.1.4 of Micro, Small and Medium Industries Policy 2008 and Application Form VI of Guidelines for Administration of Incentives and Concessions in the Policy”.

3. The Government after careful examination, have decided to accept the proposal of the Industries Commissioner and Director of Industries and Commerce in para 2 above and issue the following amendments:-

AMENDMENTS TO MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM INDUSTRIES POLICY 2008

- a) At the end of para 6.1.4, under the caption “Back-Ended Interest Subsidy” of the Micro, Small and Medium Industries Policy in the Government Order first read above, the following words shall be added:-

“and by the units assisted under National Equity Fund Scheme (Renamed as Micro / Small Enterprises Funding Scheme) and Credit Guarantee Fund Trust Scheme of Government of India”.

- b) In the Government Order read above, in Annexure-II under the caption “Guidelines for Administration of Incentives and Concessions in the Policy”, under Form VI, the following entries shall be made:-

i) The title “Application for claiming Back-Ended Interest Subsidy for Technology Upgradation and Modernisation” shall be substituted with the words **“Application for claiming Back-ended Interest Subsidy for technology upgradation and modernization, National Equity Fund Scheme (Renamed as Micro / Small Enterprises Funding Scheme) and Credit Guarantee Fund Trust Scheme of Government of India”.**

ii) In column 6.1, of Form VI, an additional row of **“National Equity Fund Scheme (Renamed as Micro / Small Enterprises Funding Scheme) and Credit Guarantee Fund Trust Scheme”** shall be included after the row “% of capacity increase on Technology Upgradation / Modernization”.

iii) In Sl.No. 7, of Form VI, the following additional row **“7.3 National Equity Fund Scheme (Renamed as Micro / Small Enterprises Funding Scheme) and Credit Guarantee Fund Trust Scheme”** shall be included.

4. This order shall take effect from 22.02.2008.

5. The Government further direct that the enterprises, which would be benefitted by the above amendments, but who have not filed their application so far, shall be given a time limit of one month from the date of issue of this order to file subsidy applications with the respective authorities as a special case.

6. This order issues with the concurrence of the Finance Department vide its U.O.No. 43517/Ind/2010, dated 30.08.2010.
