In the Government letters 2nd and 3rd cited. 12 (7+5) supernumerary posts have been allotted to the Commercial Taxes and Religious Endowments Department for distribution in a judicious manner to all the Offices under its administrative control, so as to provide employment assistance to the dependent of deceased Government servants of that Department, waiting for such appointment. From the aforesaid allotment, 7 (seven) supernumerary posts have been allotted to the Commercial Taxes Department. It is now reported that having fully utilized the seven supernumerary posts allotted, the Special Commissioner and Commissioner of Commercial Taxes has created one more supernumerary post in the common category of Junior Assistant, so as to employ the request of one such waiting candidate, in the Office of the Deputy Commissioner of Commercial Taxes, Thirunelveli Region, without prior sanction of the Government considering the indigent circumstances of the family of the deceased.

2. The Commercial Taxes and Religious Endowment Department has proposed to ratify the action of the Special Commissioner and Commissioner of Commercial

Taxes in having created one supernumerary post in the category of Junior Assistant and have requested for allotment of one supernumerary post to that Department.

3. The Government after careful examination, have decided to accept the proposal of the Commercial Taxes and Religious Endowment Department and accordingly re-allocate one more supernumerary post to that Department, in addition to the 12 posts already allocated, in the Government letters second and third cited. The Government also ratify the action of the Special Commissioner and Commissioner of Commercial Taxes in having created one supernumerary post in the office of the Deputy Commissioner of Commercial Taxes, Thirunelveli without prior sanction of the Government.

4. Kind attention is also invited to para 12 of the Government order first cited wherein it has been ordered that the supernumerary posts allotted to each Department should be used as a cushion to clear the backlog and that the incumbents of the supernumerary posts should be shifted to regular vacancies as and when arise and the pool of supernumerary post should be restored for providing employment to the next candidate waiting in the list, if there is any or the unutilized posts should be surrendered to the Government for re-allocation to other needy Departments.
