Sub : Public Services - Retrospective regularisation of services of persons appointed temporarily otherwise than in accordance with the rules by relaxation of rules - Proposals - Regarding.

I am directed to state that in the Government Order cited, among others, instructions have been issued to the effect that the appointing authorities shall furnish a list of irregular appointments made as on date to the Heads of Departments who will forward the same to the administrative departments of Secretariat concerned and desist from making further irregular appointments. It has also been instructed therein that the appointing authorities should send proposals to the Government on or before 31.12.1992 for ratification of appointments irregularly made so far and that the time limit would not be extended further.

2. I am to reiterate these instructions and to request you to expedite the old proposals so as to reach Government on or before 31.12.1992 positively.
