From the Director, Anna Institute of Management and Director General of Training Letter No.DGT /101/2008, dated 16.10.2009.

ORDER:

In her letter read above the Additional Chief Secretary/ Director, Anna Institute of Management & Director General of Training has sent detailed proposals for the establishment of All India Civil Services Coaching Centre at Madurai and Coimbatore. The Additional Chief Secretary/ Director, Anna Institute of Management & Director General of Training has stated that the possibility of tie-up with the Universities situated in Coimbatore, Madurai were explored and has proposed to tie-up with the Universities at Coimbatore, Madurai to start All India Civil Services Coaching Centres. The Model scheme envisages for training of 100 students for preliminary and main examination every year and the expenditure involved will be Rs.10 lakhs (Non-recurring expenditure to be borne by the University) and Rs.11.30 lakhs per annum. (Recurring expenditure to be borne by the Government) as detailed below:-

2. The Additional Chief Secretary/ Director, Anna Institute of Management and Director General of Training has stated that the Vice Chancellors of Bharathiar University and the Madurai Kamarajar University have informed that the University will be able to accommodate 100 students under this programme in their hostels at free of cost.

3. The Anna Institute of Management is now adopting the Communal rotation as existed in the two Institutions which were merged (viz. institutes of the Special Training Institute (BC) and Pre-examination Training Centres (SC and ST) in 2000 and it is proposed to adopt communal rotation as followed by the Government in the case of all Education/ Public Employment.

4. Further, the Additional Chief Secretary/ Director, Anna Institute of Management and Director General of Training has stated that the University will constitute a Governing Committee to look after the Academy and the Academy may be christened as Anna Centenary Civil Services Coaching Academy. The Governing Committee will be as follows:-

1. Chairman - Vice Chancellor
2. Members - Three Professors of the University

The Government have examined the proposal of the Additional Chief Secretary/ Director, Anna Institute of Management & Director General of Training in detail and decided to accept the proposal of the Additional Chief Secretary/ Director, Anna Institute of Management and Director General of Training for the establishment of two All India Civil Services Coaching Centre in the name of Anna Centenary Civil Services Coaching Academy one at Madurai Kamarajar University, Madurai and another at Bharathiar University, Coimbatore at a cost of Rs.10 lakhs (Non-Recurring expenditure to be borne by University) and Rs.10.80 lakhs (Recurring expenditure borne by the Government) for each Academy on the following conditions:-

- (i) Non-recurring expenditure and hostel facilities would be provided by the University without any claim of funds for the same from Anna Institute of Management or Government.
- (ii) The break-up of the cost and the rates mentioned by the Additional Chief Secretary/ Director, Anna Institute of Management and Director General of Training at para 1 above to be strictly followed with the following changes:-
 - (a) Office Contingency reduced to Rs.1 lakh against Rs.1.20 lakhs.
 - (b) Programme Co-ordinator fee to be reduced to Rs.7,500 p.m. from Rs.10,000 p.m. for 12 months totaling Rs.90,000/-
- (iii) The section of 100 candidates for each academy should be made by adopting Communal Rotation as followed by Government in the case of all Education/ Public Employment.
- (iv) The Governing Committee will consist of the following:
 1. Chairman - Vice Chancellor
 2. Members - Three Professors of the University/
District Collector/
Principal, All India Civil Services Coaching Centre ,
Anna Nagar, Chennai.
 3. Member Secretary - Faculty i/c of the Academy in the University


