### ORDER:

The Government in their order fourth read above, issued orders revising the scheme of district training for Section Officers and Under Secretaries to Government in the Departments of Secretariat other than Law and Finance including Planning, Development and Special Initiatives Departments and according to which undergoing six months district training is made compulsory for them and it is a pre-requisite qualification for promotion to the post of Under Secretary to Government and Deputy Secretary to Government respectively. Among the various conditions prescribed therein for deputing to district training, the Section Officers should have put in 2 years of service as Section Officer and should have a left over service of 3 years before retirement. According to the orders issued in the Government Order fourth read above and in the Government Order fifth read above, the Under Secretaries to Government should have put in one year of service as Under Secretary to Government and should have a left over service of 3 years before retirement for deputing them to district training. Government Order sixth read above, the conditions relating to pre-requisite service as Section Officer for 2 years and Under Secretary as one year was removed and it was ordered that in future, the Section Officers / Under Secretaries to Government in the Departments of Secretariat other than Law and Finance including Planning, Development and Special Initiatives Departments be deputed for district training immediately on promotion subject to fulfillment of other conditions for district training. Thereafter, in the Government Order seventh read above, orders were issued to the effect that the Under Secretary to Government who have got two years of left over service before their retirement shall be eligible for deputation for district training subject to availability of vacancies in districts and fulfillment of other conditions for district training.

2. The Tamil Nadu Secretariat Association in its letter dated 28.11.2006 has made a representation to the Government requesting them to reduce the left over service before retirement for the deputation to district training for the Under Secretaries to Government / Section Officers to one year / two years respectively.

3. The Government after careful examination have decided to revise the condition relating to possessing of two years / three years of left over service before retirement for the Under Secretaries to Government / Section Officers for compulsory district training into one year / two years respectively. Accordingly, the Government direct that the Under Secretaries to Government / Section Officers of the Departments of Secretariat other than Law and Finance including Planning, Development and Special Initiatives Departments, who have got one year / two years of left over service respectively before their retirement shall be made eligible for deputation for compulsory district training subject to availability of vacancies in districts for District Training and fulfillment of other conditions prescribed for district training .

4. This order shall take effect from the date of issue of the order.


