ORDER:

In the Order first read above, the Government ordered that the erstwhile Dharmapuri District be bifurcated into Dharmapuri District with headquarters at Dharmapuri and Krishnagiri District with headquarters at Krishnagiri. Consequent on the above, the Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption has submitted a proposal to declare the existing Krishnagiri Special Unit of the Directorate of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption as a regular unit and to declare it as a Police Station under section 2 (s) of the Code of Criminal Procedure.

2. The Government after careful consideration, decided to accept the above proposal of the Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption. They, accordingly, order that the existing Special Unit at Krishnagiri be declared as regular unit to deal with the corruption cases in Krishnagiri Revenue District.
