Directorate of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption – Creation of Two more Vigilance and Anti-Corruption detachments at Tiruppur and Thiruvannamalai – Orders – Issued.

Order :

The creation of new Revenue District Head Quarters resulted in all round development with the need to curb corruption. The residents of the newly created districts, find it very difficult to approach the detachment offices located in neighbouring district due to distance and it discourages them to report their complaints in time. The unwieldy jurisdiction of having two or more districts is not congenial for the investigation officers to perform their work to curb corruption correctly at the earliest point of time.

2. The Government, considering the above said position and with a view to providing a corruption free Governance and to give easy access to the Public in making complaints against Corrupt practice, the Government hereby sanction and creates

(i) two new moffusil detachments of Directorate of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption at Tiruppur and Thiruvannamalai each with the strength of one Deputy Superintendent of Police, Two Head Constables and Three Police Constables (Including one Driver PC). Personnel for each detachment which will be redeployed from the existing sanctioned strength of SIC and two Inspectors of Police will be redeployed from the existing sanctioned strength of Vellore and Coimbatore detachments as detailed in the annexure to this order. The vehicles, furniture, Computer and Accessories, Photocopying Machines and Fax Machines will be reallocated from the existing allotment. The Office and Residential Telephone connections will be transferred to the above new places for installation at the time of forming of the detachments from the Chennai city. The cellular phones used by the officers will be transferred to the new detachment office, i.e., Thiruvannamalai and Tiruppur.

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(ii) sanction a recurring expenditure of Rs.2,88,000/- per year (Rupees Two lakh and Eighty Eight thousands only) (i.e Rs.12,000/- per month each) is sanctioned towards rental expenditure of the two detachment offices.

3. The expenditure shall be debited to the following head of account:-

4. Necessary additional funds for the expenditure sanctioned in para 2 above will be provided in RE/FMA 2012-13 based on the proposals to be received to this effect from the Director of Vigilance and Anti-Corruption, Chennai – 28.

5. The pay and Accounts Officer (South), Chennai-35, Treasury Officer, Thiruppur and Tiruvannamalai are directed to take note of the post sanction redeployment details given in the annexure to this order in their registers.

6. The Treasury Officer, Tiruppur and Tiruvannamalai are directed to take into account the head of account indicated in this order in their records, assign D.O. Code and issue TNTC 70 Registers to the officers concerned of the detachments.


